"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Christians claim to believe the Bible is God's Word. We claim it's God's divinely inspired message to us. Yet despite this, we aren't reading it. A LifeWay Research study done just a few years ago found only 45 percent of those who regularly attend Church read the Bible more than once a week. Over 40 percent of the people attending read their Bible occasionally, maybe once or twice a month. Almost 1 in 5 Churchgoers say they never read the Bible - essentially the same number who read it every day.

I don't think I'm going out on the proverbial limb when I say I'm convinced that 2019 stats would reveal that a larger number of Churchgoers have never read the Bible and fewer read the Word daily. Scarier still is the prospect that less than forty percent of active Pastors read their Bibles every day. It's really embarrassing to hear Pastors or Ministry Associates, persons who are expected to be familiar with the Holy Writ, to quote the wrong chapter and verse with conviction. I'll never forget the Pastor who, while preaching a funeral, started talking about Adam, Eve and the Edenic tragedy and told those mourners seated in the packed sanctuary that they could find the story in Genesis 25. I could somewhat overlook the eulogist's nescience vis à vis hermeneutical principles and exegetical methods, but relocating Adam and Eve to Genesis 25 was a bit much.

How about ministry/auxiliary leaders? It probably would be heartbreaking to know the percentage of Church lay leaders who open their Bibles at least once a week. And, because we don't read God's Word, it follows that we don't know it.

Alistair Begg, Senior Pastor at Parkside Church near Cleveland, Ohio, comments: "If you combine the decline of personal Bible reading and the notion of family devotions, it doesn't take very long before the impact of Biblical malnutrition begins to show itself." Jerry Vines, former Pastor of First Baptist Church of Jacksonville, Florida states, "We are bringing up a generation of young people who are sitting ducks for the secular culture. When they head off to college, they don't receive a solid Biblical worldview, and many fall off one by one and reject outright the teachings of the Bible."

a lack of Biblical doctrine. When was the last time you heard a preacher of any ilk teach on Biblical Distinctives? What about soteriology, justification,



sanctification, or even apologetics? Truth is, many professing Christians are unfamiliar with Christian speech. People arrive on Sunday morning without a working knowledge of the cause they allege to embrace. When people don't know, and don't really care to know, the content of Christianity, it becomes increasingly difficult to build a faith community! And, I've discovered, much to my chagrin, that whenever Church folk don't know the Word of God, they fall back on "The way I see it..." or "In my opinion..." or "The way I figure it...

I get it. Most Churches are rightfully focused on augmenting attendance worship attendance, small groups attendance. Midweek attendance. etc. Consequently, we've found many creative ways to attract believers and unbelievers to our Churches. We've worked hard to remove every impediment we could find and make attending our Churches as convenient as possible. And in many ways, it has worked. People who wouldn't otherwise attend Church are now filling our seats. But, once we get them there it is our responsibility (and should be our delight) to teach them what the Bible says! One thing the Bible quotes God as saying is, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hosea

We need to make sure the Bible is front and center in our Churches and then in our homes. Just having a Bible app on our phones will not make a difference in our Churches and Communities. I believe in the power of the Holy Spirit to be our strength and our teacher, but if we ignore God's Book and its prophetic promises, we hinder the Spirit's ability to accomplish God's will among us.

"Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Life Undeniably Persevering in Prayer'

Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (James 1:4)

Last month I shared the importance of undeniably persevering in prayer despite the difficulty life brings with little to no indication of success. To develop this mindset requires that you establish your own personal prayer closet. A prayer closet is a place free from interruption and distraction.

The enemy DOES NOT want you to establish this secret place because he knows it is a hub station of mass destruction against him so he will do whatever he can to bring calamity, interruption, and distraction in your life. This is why it is my passion and desire to awaken and ignite the prayer warrior in every believer. You have to reach a point in your life where you cannot survive without a visit to the prayer closet. It might be a daily commute, a bench in the back yard, a chair on the front porch, a walk by the lake, etc. It is a designated place where you persevere in prayer, seek the Father's face, cry out

in His presence, place your cares and anxious thoughts at His feet, listen for His instruction, and receive His grace to get up and keep

View your Prayer Closet with the following perspective:

- · A place for personal devotion and development. This is your time to worship the Father, which fosters an intimacy that causes you to begin to grow and develop a lifestyle of prayer. These private one-on-one intimate sessions with the Father will birth a powerful public Kingdom ministry in you. (Mat. 6:6)
- A place of escape and exposure. This is your mini retreat for spiritual rest and opportunity for your heart to be exposed, delivered, and healed. (Ps. 139:23-24)
- A place of petition and praise. Here in this place, requests are released and thanksgiving is extended in faith for what the Father will work out on your behalf. (Philip 4:6-7; Rom 8:28)

Perseverance is the radiance of God's glory manifesting in your life, demonstrating your total confidence in Him knowing that whatever you need, He has already supplied it by faith through Christ Jesus. Perseverance car-



ries an incentive that when it finishes what it is supposed to do, an eternal reward is given. "Blessed is the man who perseveres under trial, because when he has stood the test, he will receive the crown of life that God has promised to those who love him." (James 1:12). This is why you can rise and declare, "I Am **UP-Undeniably Persevering in** Praver!"

Next month I will share with you some practical steps you can implement that will help develop a lifestyle of persevering in prayer. Until then, be determined to establish your private prayer closet and begin to enjoy fellowship with the Father as He intended, undeniably persevering in prayer.







The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word...

Rev. J.R. Brumfield

Sharing the Good News 1 Corinthians 15:1-8

I. INTRODUCTION

It has been widely published through the annuals of time that Jesus Christ is God's Salvation to humanity. Jesus is God's great gift to a lost world. Deliverance from our sins is not predicated upon man's doing but rather we must look at the work on the cross of Calvary. Jesus paid it all and all to Him we owe. From the very beginning of time, our Lord had a plan for man's fall in the Garden before it happened. The Lord God knew that humanity would suffer a loss in the Garden. The Lord God knew that man would go astray and disobey Him. In Genesis 2:16-17, God commanded Adam not to eat of the forbidden fruit less he would die. However, we find that Adam and Eve both ate of the forbidden fruit and they suffered the consequences. Our first parents were forced to leave the beautiful Garden of Eden and live outside of God's perfect will for their lives. Yet, the Lord God had a plan of salvation. When we mess up, we can make up with God because of faith in Jesus Christ. This is the plan of salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

In Isaiah 61:1-3, we are told that Jesus would come to bind up the broken heartened and preach deliverance to the captives. When Adam sinned in the Garden, a breach in the contractual relationship between God and man occurred. We needed a Savior to stand in the gap for lost humanity. Jesus came down through forty and two generations. He went about doing good and he died on an old rugged cross. Yes, he died on Friday but early Sunday morning He got up with all power. This is the good news of the gospel.

It was prophesied by Old Testament prophets that Jesus would pay the penalty for our sins. As we survey the canvas of Old Testament Scripture, we find several references to the suffering of our Lord. If Jesus would not have taken on the form of the suffering servant, we would be a people trapped in the captivity of sin. He thought it not robbery to come down from His place in glory to die a substitutionary death for our sakes. He paid the full payment for our sins with His suffering.

In Psalms 22:7-8, David foretells of how the people would mock Christ. We find that Matthew gives illustration of Christ being mocked in Mat 27:41-43. In Psalms 22:18, it was prophesied that they would cast lots to divide up his clothes. In Mat 27:35, we see the fulfillment of prophesy because they parted his garment among them and upon his vesture they cast lots. Jesus was mocked and ridiculed for our sakes. In Psalms 22:14, it was prophesied that His bones were out of joint. It was prophesied in Psalms 22:16 of how the wicked had surrounded him and pierced his hands and feet. These were the scars of which Thomas later got to touch and feel in John 20:27. In Psalm 22, it ends by saying God's righteousness would be declared to "a people that shall be born" (Psalm 22:31). This brings us to our text in 1 Corinthians 15:1-11. The apostle Paul informs the reader of the good news of the gospel. Let's see what the Apostle Paul has to tell us about our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.



II. CONSISTENT MESSAGE, v.1-2

The apostle Paul always preached the same Word. It was not a different gospel to suit different audiences. He taught the same truth. This was an appeal that the Apostle Paul used to gain his hearers' attention in Corinth. There was a heresy that was propagated among the early church that the Sadducees wanted everyone to believe. They wanted the church to accept a false doctrine that Christ did not rise from the dead because they did not believe in the Resurrection. Yet, the Apostle Paul sets sail to correct this error in the early church at Corinth. The doctrine that Paul taught was the same doctrine that he was constantly teaching in Corinth. This was a doctrine that the church at Corinth had already received from the Apostle Paul. The doctrine of Christ's death and resurrection is at the foundation of Christianity. If we take anything away from this doctrine, then our salvation is in vain. It is because of the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ that we go to church on Sunday.

As believers in Christ, we must not allow anything or anybody to shake our faith in the firm foundation of Jesus Christ and His righteousness. We are declared righteous because of the atoning work of Jesus Christ. Had it not been for the cross of Christ, we would be a people most miserable. There is no other name given under heaven by which we may be saved. The crucifixion of our Lord and his conquest over death are the very sources of our spiritual life. It is these things that we must hold onto and not let anything distract us from this truth of the gospel. The saving truths of the gospel must be fixed in our minds. We must not waver in our faith in Jesus Christ. He is the same yesterday, today, and forever more.

III. CONTENT OF THE MESSAGE

The Apostle Paul stated in these verses, "For I delivered to you first that which I also received." Basically, the Apostle Paul did not make up this gospel. He received it from Jesus Christ as written in Galatians 1:11-12. After the Apostle Paul received the gospel, he then delivered it. This is not "Paul's gospel" in the sense that he created it or fashioned it. It is "Paul's gospel" in the sense that he personally believes it and spreads it. Do you believe the report of the gospel? Have you shared the good news of the gospel?

It is important to note that the gospel does not originate with the preacher. If he makes it, it is of little significance because it is not based on the Solid Rock of God's truth. As preachers of the Word, we are not makers and inventors of the gospel, but we are repeaters of the gospel as stated by Charles Spurgeon.

As Paul describes the gospel in the following verses, it is important to notice that this gospel is not insightful teaching or good advice. The core of the gospel involves real events that happened centuries ago and the message is still good for today's world. The gospel isn't a matter of religious opinions, platitudes, or fairy tales, but about real historical events regarding Jesus Christ.

In this passage, we find that the Apostle Paul confirms the message again. The Apostle Paul tells the church at Corinth that He died for our sins. This consistent message is confirmed and reaffirmed by the Apostle Paul. He tells the reader that He died and He was buried. Afterwards, Jesus arose from the dead as it was prophesied. Have you accepted God's plan of salvation through faith in Jesus Christ?

IV. CONCRETE EVIDENCE OF THE GOSPEL MESSAGE, v.5-8

Though no one saw the actual resurrection of Jesus, many people saw the resurrected Jesus. Paul now calls forth these witnesses to the resurrection to establish beyond all controversy that Jesus was raised from the dead

He was seen by Cephas (Peter). Jesus made a special resurrection appearance to Peter (Luke 24:34). We are not told much about this visit, but we can assume there was some special need for Peter to be comforted by our Lord Jesus Christ.

Afterwards, Jesus was seen by the twelve disciples. This probably refers to the first meeting Jesus had with His assembled disciples, mentioned in Mark 16:14, Luke 24:36-43, and John 20:19-25. This was the meeting where Jesus appeared in the room with the doors and windows shut and breathed on the disciples. This event resulted in giving the Holy Spirit to the disciples.

The meeting of Jesus with over five hundred brethren at once isn't detailed in the gospels. However it is suggested by Matthew 28:10, 16-17. During the time after His resurrection, but before His Ascension, Jesus seemed to meet with His followers on many different occasions.

Nevertheless, when I think about what he has done for me, my soul testifies to a lively hope of the Resurrection. I know that my Redeemer lives because He lives inside of me. Are you connected to the Father by faith in Jesus Christ? I suggest to you that we serve a Risen Savior!
