"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

The gospelist Luke tells us that during the Last Supper, after Jesus shared that one of the disciples would betray him, something unexpected happened (Luke 20:24-27). Instead of leaning into reflection or humility, the disciples started arguing about who was the most committed. Who was the greatest. Who stood out above the rest.



It's about relationships.

It's a somber moment, but it's also a familiar one. Because that's how leadership often works in our culture. People fight tooth-and-nail by positioning themselves advantageously. They measure themselves against others. They compete for recognition, influence and status. Whether it's in organizations, workplaces, or even churches, the pull toward "being the greatest" can quietly shape how people lead.

Jesus doesn't ignore what's happening. He names it. He says, "In this world the kings and great men lord it over their people, yet they are called 'friends of the people'" (Luke 20:25, NLT). The disciples understood exactly what he meant. They'd seen leaders use power to control, to elevate themselves and to maintain their position. And if we're honest, we've seen it too. Leadership in the world often centers on authority, visibility and control.

But then Jesus says something that changes everything: "But among you it will be different" (Luke 20:26).

That one sentence draws a sharp, crystal-clear line between the way the culture leads, and the way God's people are called to lead. In God's kingdom, leadership isn't about climbing higher. It's not about being served. It's about choosing to serve.

Jesus reframes greatness. He makes it practical and personal. The greatest isn't the one with the most influence, the loudest voice, the corner office, the one with the largest social media footprint or the highest title. The greatest is the one who serves. The one who pays attention to people. The one who uses whatever authority they have to lift others, not themselves.

For church leaders, both lay and clergy, this matters deeply. Because leadership in the church is never just about roles or responsibilities.

Leading by serving shows up in everyday ways. It shows up in how you speak to people, especially when you're stressed and under pressure. It shows up in whether you listen or just respond. It shows up in whether you make space for others to grow or feel the need to control every outcome.

It also shows up in quiet, unseen ways. Praying for and with people. Following up when someone is struggling. Being present when it would be easier to stay distant.

Jesus doesn't just teach this. He models it. He says, "I am among you as the one who serves" (Luke 20:27). In other words, "If you want to understand leadership, look at how I live." He leads with presence. He leads with compassion. He leads with intentional care for others.

That's the invitation for every church leader. To see leadership not as a platform, but as a responsibility. Not as a position to protect, but as an opportunity to serve.

When leaders serve, people feel valued. When leaders serve, trust grows. When leaders serve, the church begins to reflect the very character of the One it follows. So the question isn't whether you're leading. The question is how.

Lead by serving.

A Life Worth Living Because He Lives

"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." (Galatians 2:20)

Each of us has one life to live here on this earth. Every day you choose how to live that life. You can live carelessly without a thought of any consequences. Or, you can live intentionally with purpose. Life has a way of interrupting your flow, and if you are not careful, you could end up in a whirlwind of destruction. Apart from Christ, no one can find total satisfaction in themselves. This is because depraved, sinful man needs someone who can heal his soul and renew his spirit. That restoration was fulfilled through the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

Jesus descended from the heavens to live here on this earth, endure the cross, despise the shame, and fulfill the law (Hebrews 12:2). He became our propitiation (satisfied the wrath of God against our sin and against us), restoring our fellowship with the Almighty Elohim, our Creator (Romans 3:25). The Risen Savior rose from the grave with all power in His hand and is alive. Because He lives, we too can live and reign with Him forever. This means we must live in a way that not only pleases God but also

gives the assurance and confidence that life has purpose and meaning. 1 Thessalonians 4:1-2 NLT, "Finally, dear brothers and sisters, we urge you in the name of the Lord Jesus to live in a way that pleases God, as we have taught you. You live this way already, and we encourage you to do so even more. 2 For you remember what we taught you by the authority of the Lord Jesus."

To be "crucified" with Christ means to separate oneself from 1) that which **offends** God (**sin**), 2) from the **shame** that sin brought on your life, 3) the **guilt** of failure sin led you to, and 4) the mental distress and hurt sin brought upon your life. These things become dead to you. So if they become dead to you, you can live through Christ.

Live in a way where the Kingdom is represented and highly exalted. Colossians 1:10-11 NLT "...10 that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; 11 strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy."

Live in a way where you can have satisfaction within yourself that you are about your Father's business. Galatians 6:4-5 NLT "4 Pay careful attention to your own work, for then you will get the satisfaction of a job well done, and you won't need to compare yourself to anyone else. 5 For we are each responsible for our own conduct."



Live an honest life. 1 Thess 4:11 NLT "Make it your goal to live a quiet life, minding your own business and working with your hands, just as we instructed you before. 12 Then people who are not believers will respect the way you live, and you will not need to depend on others."

In this earthly body, live by faith--total assurance in the provisions and promises of God--that He will keep you, help you, deliver you, and guide you. Acts 17:28a, "For in him we live, and move, and have our being."

So dear hearts, be determined to live in a manner that reminds you that life is worth living because He lives.

Honor the Ground That Helped Build a Nation. Historic New Trinity Cemetery deserves national recognition during America's 250th anniversary.

central to it.

That is why the effort to designate New Trinity Cemetery as a National Historical Landmark is so important.

The goal is clear: to secure national recognition for this sacred ground as a site honoring Black military veterans who served this country across every generation. This designation would affirm what has long been true — that the contributions and sacrifices of these veterans are essential to the American story.

As the nation prepares to mark its 250th anniversary, this moment calls for more than celebration. It calls for reflection, responsibility and restoration.

If we are to honor freedom, we must also honor those who made that freedom possible — even when they were denied its full promise.

For too long, New Trinity Ceme-

tory has remained a hidden treasure, sustained by community care but lacking national recognition. That must change.

You cannot tell the story of America without telling the story of these men and women. And you cannot tell their story without honoring the ground where they rest.

Recognizing New Trinity Cemetery as a National Historical Landmark is not just appropriate — it is overdue.

This is a moment to preserve, to proclaim and to protect.

New Trinity Cemetery is a national treasure. It is time for the nation to say so.

FORT WORTH, Texas — As the United States approaches its 250th anniversary, the nation faces an important question: Will we simply celebrate, or will we also tell the full truth about who built, defended and sustained this country?

Part of that truth lies in the sacred ground of New Trinity Cemetery in Haltom City, Texas.

This is more than a cemetery. It is a living archive of American courage — the final resting place of more than 500 Black veterans who served in every major conflict from the Civil War to the War on Terror. It is also a place where history, leadership and sacrifice converge in ways rarely found elsewhere in the nation.

These men and women fought for freedoms they were often denied. They served a country that did not always serve them. Yet they answered the call with honor, courage and unwavering commitment.

Their legacy deserves more than remembrance. It demands recognition.

New Trinity Cemetery is one of the few sites in America where generations of Black military service are preserved together. Among those buried there are pioneers whose lives helped shape both their communities and the nation: Dr. Riley A. Ransom, a respected leader and educator; Dr. Veda Fielder, a trailblazer in education; L.D. Livingston, a Negro League baseball player, World War II veteran and former Harlem police officer; and Technician Fifth Grade Florence Marie Rawls, a Congressional Gold Medal recipient and member of the 6888th Central Postal Directory Battalion — the only all-Black and Afro-Mexican women's unit to serve overseas during World War II.

Their stories are not separate from American history. They are

On Friday, April 24, the Fort Worth Police Department (FWPD) will conduct its Law Enforcement Torch Run (LETR) for Special Olympics Texas. The event will be held at the Shops at Clearfork, with registration starting at 8 a.m. and opening ceremonies beginning at 9 a.m.

The event is open to the public for the two-mile run. There is also a one-mile ruck/walk.

FWPD raises money in various ways throughout the year, including Tip-A-Cop events at Texas Roadhouse and Polar Plunges. For the department, the Torch Run brings together local law enforcement officers and community members to raise funds and awareness for the Special Olympics.

Wichita Police Chief Richard LaMunyon created the LETR in 1981 to help law enforcement be active in the community and support Special Olympics Kansas. In 1983, Chief LaMunyon presented the program to the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP), which officially endorsed the Torch Run as its "Founding Law Enforcement Organization." With the IACP's support, LETR became the movement's largest public awareness and fundraising group for Special Olympics.

Known as Guardians of the Flame, law enforcement members and Special Olympics athletes carry the "Flame of Hope" into Opening Ceremonies of local competitions. They also carry it into Special Olympics State, Provincial, National, Regional and World Games. There are over 97,000 law enforcement members who carry the Flame of Hope annually. The flame symbolizes courage and celebration of diversity, uniting communities around the globe. Since the beginning, LETR has raised over \$600 million for Special Olympics programs.
