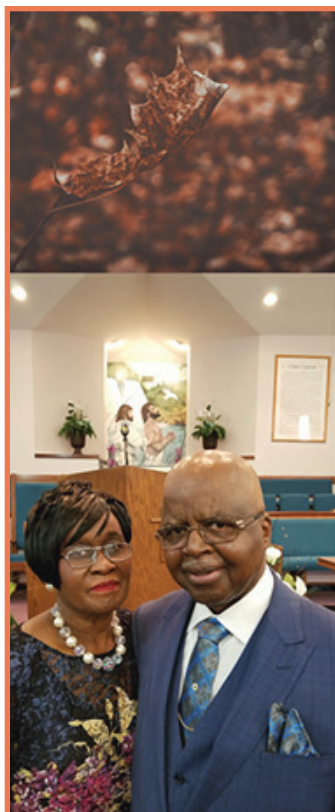

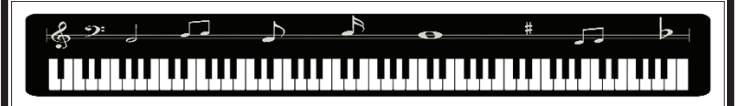

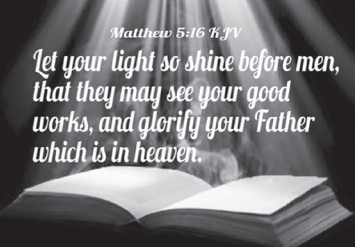

"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

People, and not exclusively Christians, ask me all kinds of questions. And, one of recurring interrogatives I'm often asked is, "Why should I pray? The Lord knows everything that is going to happen anyway, so do my prayers make a difference?"

Of course, the obvious answer to that question is: "Jesus told us to pray and he never asks us to do something he didn't do himself." Matthew, Mark, Luke and John... all accentuate key moments when Jesus prayed. Matthew records nine such incidents; Mark, eight; Luke, 13; and John, five. From these 35 references, there are 23 separate occasions.

We see Jesus praying often in the midst of many different kinds of situations. For example, he prays while making decisions, confronting adversity, doing miracles, experiencing emotional distress, and interceding for his disciples. Jesus is in constant communion with God as he ministers to others. And, since Jesus valued and prioritize prayer, so should Church leaders!

I don't remember who said, "Prayer can be defined as talking to God, but it is much more than that. Prayer is an act of worship that glorifies God and reinforces our need for him." But, whoever it was is on point! And, prayer should be an integral part and parcel of a Church leader's life. A Church leader can't go about his or her service unto the Lord without praying.

One of the grievous weaknesses of the 21st Century Church is prayerless Church leaders! Deacons used to lead "devotion" at the onset of worship and now you rarely or barely find deacons in prayer meeting. In fact, prayer meetings are scarcely attended nowadays. Tom Stuart, leader of Ignited2Pray Ministries, pulls no punches when he argues, "Leaders of a prayerless church are like the crew on a sinking ship who are more concerned



with the passengers comfort and entertainment than mustering them to the life rafts. It's time to muster people to watch and pray rather than sleep and play."

Thom Rainer has written an interesting article titled *9 Reasons Why Church Leaders Struggle With Prayer*. Rainer lists:

1. **Leaders are "fixers" by nature.** Because we pride ourselves as "problem solvers," sometimes we see "prayer to a last resort option."
2. **We never learned how to pray.** Churches are guilty of telling believers what to pray, but we don't teach them how to do it.
3. **Prayer has become more about ritual than about relationship.**
4. **Prayerlessness can be hidden.**
5. **We don't really believe prayer works.**
6. **We have never been broken under God's hand.** "It is in our weakness that we learn how to pray, but leaders naturally fight against weakness."
7. **Leaders read the Word in a one-sided way.** Leaders frequently read the Word for information transmission more than life transformation.
8. **Some leaders have simply lost hope.**
9. **We miss the Gospel focus on the prayer life of Jesus.**

A Lifestyle of Prayer

"Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Before you know it, a sense of God's wholeness, everything coming together for good, will come and settle you down. It's wonderful what happens when Christ displaces worry at the center of your life." (Philip 4:6-7 Msg)

When I first began my journey as a Pastor's Wife, I was most naïve concerning my role and responsibility. I was 21 years old, a newlywed, and a full-time legal secretary (stressful in and of itself). I loved God with my whole heart and had a passion for worship. I had a prayer life but nowhere near where it is today. I lacked confidence, had some self-esteem issues, and my greatest regret is I had no mentor. As I reflect over my life, the Father consistently dealt with me in an area I needed much building in and that's a solid prayer life. I had many successes, trials, and attacks. This is a part of living. No matter what stage in my life I was in, I seemed to always be driven to that one place and that's at the feet of the Master. After Jesus was baptized the Bible declares He was driven into the wilderness to be tested,

which He conquered, and also to be refreshed and ministered to. (See Matt. 4:1-11) I believe this is the place our Father desires us to consistently seek to be at on a daily basis.

The Apostle Paul admonishes us to not allow today's troubles to consume our thoughts and pattern of living. Instead, we are encouraged to release every weight, thought, worry, care, loss, hurt, burden or whatever you face into the Capable Hands of the Father. We do this by prostrating our mind and heart before a Holy God in prayer, surrendering our very lives and circumstances unto Him. He promised that in return you would experience such a love and trust in Him knowing that He is in control and has a way of causing ALL things to work out together for your good. For your trust, He rewards you with His peace, an assurance that all shall be well because you safely trust in Him.

As I write this article, Texas is experiencing "extreme" heat of 108 plus degree weather. The intensity of the heat is almost unbearable. We Texans are yearning for relief. I have found that in the most heated battles of life, I experience the greatest triumph of release in prayer. I can hear the Mothers of Zion say "Baby, take it the Lord in prayer." I did not



understand it back then but oh do I understand it now. I know life can deal you with some hard knocks and blows. There is a God in Heaven, Abba, who is waiting for you to come to Him so He can help, strengthen, and guide you every day of your living life on earth. I challenge you to make a conscious effort to begin your day with prayer. Take everything about you and happening to you and redirect it all to the Father. Trust His Word. Acknowledge that He is in control. Watch Him work. Receive His peace and wholeness to help you live a life of freedom in Christ. Until then my brothers and sisters, maintain a lifestyle of prayer that provokes heaven to manifest itself in your life on earth.

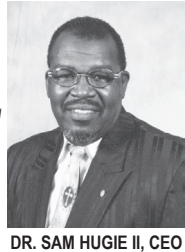

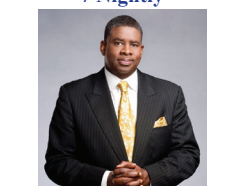

The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word...

Loving the Unlovable

Hosea 1:1-2; 1:8-11; 3:1-5

1. Introduction

It has been stated that there is no love like a mother's love. Yet, when we look at God, we see a deeper level of love. There is a labor of love in God the Father. In John 3:16, we are reminded of God's love. "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son."

According to G.K. Chesterton, "To love means loving the unlovable." How many times have you had to learn to love and accept the unlovable that's in someone else? G.K. Chesterton informs the listeners that "to forgive means to pardon the unpardonable." Do you want to be free of a heavy burden of disdain, distaste, and dislike? There are times in our lives when we must forgive others and ourselves so that we might be free. It has been literally expressed that anyone can love a rose, but it takes a great heart to include the thorns.

The name Hosea is like the name of Joshua, which signifies a savior. Prophets are an instrument of salvation of God. In V. 1, we see the authority and commission of Hosea. The bible tells us that the Word of the Lord came to Hosea. It was a powerful Word. Hosea prophesied during the days of Uzziah, Jotham, Ahaz, and Hezekiah, Kings of Judah. It was during the days of Jeroboam, King of Israel. Hosea prophesied during the reigns of several kings which indicates his ministry endured for a long time.

It was an honor to Hosea to prophesy for a long time. He started when he was young and had the advantage of strength and vigor. He prophesied when he was old and had the benefit of experience and authority. It appears that although Hosea prophesied for a long time, yet he was regarded less and less. Sometimes familiarity breeds contempt. Hosea lived during the times of Joel, Amos, Micah, Jonah, Obadiah, and Isaiah. Hosea was the first prophet of his generation to foretell the destruction of Israel.

2. God's Command, v. 2, 8-11

It is here that we find that God begins to deal with Hosea the prophet early in his life. The Lord God gets straight to the point. The Lord said, "Go, marry a promiscuous woman and have children with her. This is commanded by God to show Hosea that His people are like an adulterous wife. Can you imagine how Hosea must have felt because I am sure everyone knew Gomer's reputation. There are times when God's chosen people are guilty of unfaithfulness to the Lord. One should readily observe that it is not just one person that has done the Lord this injustice. This passage states that the whole land is guilty of unfaithfulness to the Lord. The bible tells us that all have sinned and unless we accept Jesus as our personal Savior, we stand condemned before the righteous judge. As a people of God, it is imperative that we stay on our knees. It has been stated that we sin either by omission or commission. There are times when we sin knowingly or unknowingly. As believers in the body of Christ,



we should never forget to pray for our sins and for our communities. The bible tells us that Hosea obeyed the Lord God and married Gomer.

When the Lord's people choose to seek worldly pleasures instead of the gospel, then we are behaving like Gomer. When we choose the sin nature instead of being governed by the Christ-nature, we are behaving like Gomer. When we choose to spend more time at the casinos than at the church house, we are behaving like Gomer. The Lord God wants and demands our attention. We should always remember that the Lord has done too much for us and we should be forever grateful for His kindness toward us. We should be faithful to our God!

When we look at today's world, we see that humanity is getting more wicked and sinful. Everywhere you look, there is trouble. There is trouble in the land. There is trouble when young innocent lives are snuffed out by gun violence. There is trouble in the land when immigrant families are separated with little prospect of reuniting with love ones. There is trouble on every hand, but the Word of God tells us that He will never leave us or forsake us. This is the primary reason that we must continue to stay prayed up and be on guard against the wiles of Satan.

In verse 8 it states, "You are not my people, and therefore I will not be your God." If the Lord gets angry with His people, then we have a problematic situation. We don't want the Lord to turn His back on us because we are stubborn and stiff-necked. If God is angry with anyone, it is because of sin in one's life. When we sin, it is necessary that we repent and get back in right fellowship with God. We see the fulfillment of this passage when Israel was taken away into the land of Assyria. Israel had a reputation for getting in trouble with the Lord because of sin. Sometimes we get in trouble with the Lord because of sin. Yet, the Lord will always have a remnant in the land. Here, as before, mercy is remembered during wrath; the rejection, as it shall not be total, so it shall not be final (v. 10, v. 11). Yet the number of the children of Israel shall be as the sand of the sea. See how the same hand that wounded is stretched forth to heal, and how tenderly he that has torn binds up. Although the Lord gets angry at times with His people, he will have compassion, and will gather with everlasting kindness. We should thank the Lord God for Jesus! In 1 Corinthians 13:13, we are reminded that three things will last forever, faith, hope, and love- and the greatest of these is love. God's love and compassion will remain with His people that accept the work of Jesus at the cross. One must be born again!

3. God's Unfailing Love, 3:1-5

Although Israel had done wrong, our God still had some mercy in reserve. When we look at the life of Hosea, we see God's unfailing love. The Lord told Hosea in this passage that Gomer (Hosea's wife) has many lovers but he must continue loving her. How many times have you had to continue loving people that did not treat you right? The Lord told Hosea to keep on loving because it is an example of the Lord's love for Israel. The Lord God continues to love us although we sometimes turn to other gods. Sometimes people make gods out of their cars, homes, family, bank accounts, and they are slaves to the almighty dollar bill. We should have no other gods before our God.

In verse 2, we find that Hosea had to purchase Gomer's freedom for six ounces of silver and nine bushels of barley. Gomer had gotten in trouble and the men did not treat her right. This is how she ended up on the auction block. When people fall victim to the vices of sin, they can end up on the auction block of life. They can find themselves in the hog pen of life. Sometimes people can sink so low that they find themselves living on the streets and away from divine protection. Don't let the devil cause you to get strung out on sin and shame. Hosea commands Gomer that she will have to stay at home with him and act like his wife. We find in this passage that Gomer only received a small portion of substance after Hosea had purchased her freedom. The object behind this reduction is that Gomer needs to be sufficiently humbled and made fully aware of her whoredoms.

Those whom God designs honor and comfort, He first makes sensible of their own worthlessness. We are like the prodigal son in the bible when we walk away from the light of the gospel. We are no longer worthy to be called thy son. It is of utmost importance that we repent and get back in right fellowship with the Lord. We see a proposal that Hosea makes with Gomer. She must be his wife and his wife alone. When we enter covenant with the Lord, we must be to Him a people, and he will be to us a God. This is the same proposal that the Lord God offered to Israel.

In closing, it is not enough to take shame to ourselves for the sins we have committed, and to justify God in correcting us for them. We must resolve in the strength of God's grace, that we will not offend any more. We must make up our minds that we will not again go after the world and the flesh. As believers in Christ, let's fight the good fight of faith and stay with the Lord until the end!
