





"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Most of us have heard the saying inspired by the Pareto's Principle (also known as the Law of Disproportionate Distribution), "80% of the work is done by 20% of the people." It always seems like there are just a corporal's guard that carry most of the load in the Church. But that can greatly hinder leadership development. So why does this happen?

Let's say you're a Senior Pastor at a program-size Church (150 to 350 active members) and you need someone to oversee the youth 1. Pray for laborers. Jesus gave people look for a person with a heart for kids AND some leadera men's ministry, so you look for a man that has a heart for men's ministry and leadership skills. And then the small groups coordinator steps down, and you need to fill her spot with someone who has a heart for discipleship and, of course, leadership skills. You eventually find a few people who want to do these assignments. but you question whether or not they have the necessary leadership skills. What is a senior leader to do? Because you have used all the leaders up in other ministries, you have to either give the job to someone who is already leading (80/20) or settle for someone who doesn't completely fit.

Throughout the Holy Writ God used men and women to lead others to accomplish great things - all to God's glory. And, I'm equally convinced, just as there aren't enough people working who should be working. . .there aren't enough leaders who should be leading. We all want our Church members to get plugged-in, but this isn't going to happen for everyone automatically. You need to have clear pathways for people to get involved. What is your Church's leadership recruitment Church leadership circle. strategy?

All the gimmicks and leadership recruiting mixers in the world can't do anything if your members never say to themselves, "I want to be a part of that." Your job is to make it clear that more effective leaders are needed.




How do we get them on board?

- and children's ministry. Most us clear guidelines for securing workers. He said, in Luke 10:2, "The harvest is plentiful, but the ship skills. You also want to start laborers are few. Therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest." Pray for laborers who have the capacity to lead.
 - 2. Show them the BIG PICTURE! You need to excite people with the Church's vision. Get them to see the bigger picture. One of the mantras we shout at my Church is "DREAM BIGGER!" Of course, you have to accept that not everyone wants to dream big. You're going to have some members who prefer to show up on the first and third Sundays and go home without any other involvement or commitments. You can't fall into the trap of catering to these people. You have to dream big and share your vision in spite of those who don't want to be involved. Just remember that dreams are
 - 3. Let them know they can make a difference. So they get the bigger picture, now show them they can have a part in it. Everybody wants to make a difference, to be influential. Show people their contribution counts.

These are just three suggestions to improve and expand your

A Treasured Life

"The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure that a man discovered hidden in a field. In his excitement, he hid it again and sold everything he owned to get enough money to buy the field.' Matthew 13:44

Treasure means a place in which good and precious things of value are collected and kept. God acknowledged man as His treasure even though he had failed. Because of love, God gave His best that He might purchase humanity back with the Blood of the Lamb. "In the house of the righteous is much treasure... Housed within our natural vessel is the treasure of faith, total reliance on God, a priceless precious commodity. The fruit of the Spirit of love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, and temperance is an ever-abiding treasure in our earthen vessel.

The beauty of God's treasures indwelling in our earthen treasure is that they are never meant to be lifeless or become unnoticeable. On the contrary, these treasures are meant to sparkle and shine



for all to see the glory of God's masterpiece at work. "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." (Matt. 5:16)







GOSPEL MUSIC ON THE MOVE

Hello to the almost-end-of-Summer. but the start of great gospel events. I am amazed at how much new music is being released and how much the gospel community seems to be doing at this time. It's absolutely a good thing and we pray it sets the atmosphere for more positivity in our country or at least as Jonathan McReynold's song suggests we "Make Room" for time with the Lord. Let me take you inside of the August events and activities occurring within gospel music as the summer closes.

The two oldest and most established gospel music organizations are holding their annual conventions this month, almost back to back. Singers and Musicians are headed to the District of Columbia for the 52nd Gospel Music Workshop of America convention. The dates are July 27-August 3, 2019 for a full week of singing and praising by the brightest and most gifted in gospel music. We know their presence will activate and deposit a stronger atmosphere for the move of God up and down Pennsylvania Avenue. Moving on.....to the 86th National Convention of Gospel Choirs and Choruses, Inc. gathering in the Motor City of Detroit, Michigan. That state is the home of some of gospel's greatest stalwarts in music and they will be present. Of major note will be the phenomenal Master Class by maestro Donald Lawrence and a full concert by the legendary Clark Sisters. This convention will meet from August 3 - August 9, 2019. New music from veteran and rising gospel artists is coming forth with impressive sales and spins on radio. I first heard Gene Moore at the Kennedy Center for Performing Arts 3 years ago at the National Gospel Music Heritage Celebration. 

Did You Tell Them About Jesus? Luke 8:26-39

I. INTRODUCTION

It has been stated that no one knows your story like you know your story. Where were you when the Lord saved you? The thief on the right side of the cross did not have much time between death and eternity. However, the Lord Jesus stopped dying to tell the man that this day, thou shall be with me in paradise. The Lord has rescued some people from turmoil and trouble. Some people were in the gutters of society and they were plagued with a sickness of the human spirit. These people would sell out their brothers and sisters for a penny in the streets. These people would tell someone that they loved them and at the same time they would stab their love ones in the back. I suggest to you when the Lord has brought you from a mighty long way, you can't help but tell somebody about Jesus. The Lord has rescued some people from the dungeon of the streets and raised them up to be preachers of His Word.

Where were you when the Lord saved you? Rufus H. McDaniel gives insight into the power of Jesus in his life. In a song he tells us, "What a wonderful change in my life has been wrought since Jesus came into my heart! I have light in my soul for which long I had sought." The soul of man seeks to know his Creator but the ruler of darkness wants to keep us in the realm of darkness. One should note that Rufus McDaniel's song of praise includes the fact that light is something that is sought after diligently. Rufus felt that the expression of song service was his way of telling others of a loving Savior Jesus Christ that saved his soul from a burning hell. One might say that Rufus felt so much gratitude to the Lord that he went on to write several spiritual songs of comfort.

In Psalm 71:15-18, we see that David wants the reader to know that when we are confronted with discouragement. we can still rejoice. It has been stated that in this passage, David was confronted with something in his own house. It was Absalom that wanted to take his father's place as king. In verse 15, we see the words, "My mouth shall shew forth thy righteousness and thy salvation all the day; for I know not the numbers." "I will go in the strength of the Lord GOD: I will make mention of thy righteousness." When we have said all that we can to the glory of God, then there is still more to be said. God is still good when trouble comes into our lives and we have something to shout about! We have a testimony to share with a lost world. David had a praise despite his personal situation. We can still tell someone about the goodness of the Lord!

As we approach the text, we will find that the Lord has a way of saving sinners that are in the grips of satanic power. Let's delve into the Word and see what the Lord has to say to the body of Christ.

II. UNFRIENDLY SPIRITS, 8:26-27

As we look at the Book of Luke, we find that Luke was concerned about the downtrodden, defeated, and discouraged of society. This story takes place



on the other side of a stormy sea. In the preceding verses, Jesus spoke to the winds and the waves in the disciples lives and there was a great calm. When one trouble is over, another trouble may be on the horizon. No soon as Jesus and his disciples went to the other side, they met a demon possessed man in the region of Gerasene.

When we look at these verses, we find that the demon-possessed man went to meet Jesus. The Word tells us that for a long time, this man had not worn clothes or lived in a house. Clothing and a place of habitation are two of the essentials of a normal healthy life. What happens when a person does not have these necessities? Since this man was demon-possessed, he was forced to make his residence among the dead. It is important to note that this man felt comfortable in the graveyard. When this demon-posessed man approached Jesus, he asked Jesus what do you want with me? In other words, I was doing alright focusing on dead stuff and dead things, but you are interrupting my way of life. What do you want with me Jesus? Now, one must acknowledge that this was not a very friendly welcoming committee. There are times when we meet with unfriendly welcoming committees. How would you feel if you went to church where the people were rude? As members of the body of Christ, we must be careful how we entertain strangers in our midst.

This man was not by himself in the graveyard. He had some company because the word tells us that there were many demons inside of this man. When a person is demon-possessed they do not want any help. What do you want with me Jesus? When Satan has a grip on one's life, then one will have an unfriendly disposition. A person will have an unfriendly personality because they are void of the light of the gospel. No one can show godly love unless the Holy Spirit resides with them. In 1 Cor. 6:19, we are reminded that God is holy, and He will not dwell in an unholy place. The demon-possessed man was so wretched that he could not entertain any thoughts of light or God's goodness. However, we know that when one meets Jesus, things will be different. When I looked at my hands, my hands looked different. When I looked at my feet, my feet looked different. When the woman at the well met Jesus, her life was changed. When lost sinners meet a holy God, then their lives will be changed!

III. UNGOVERNABLE, 8:28-29

In these verses, we ascertain that the demon-possessed man was bound with chains and fetters so he might not do anyone or himself harm. When one is placed in custody then there is an of-

fence that has been committed or one is capable of being committed. In this case, some restraints were placed on the demon-possessed man to keep him from hurting other people or himself. Have you ever issued a restraining order on someone? Or do you know someone that has received a restraining order? This demon-possessed man received a restraining order, but it did not restrain him from doing wrong. The bible gives evidence that even the chains and fetters could not hold this man. This man was ungovernable. When sin takes a grip on someone's life, then the only restraint is the presence of the Holy Spirit. If the Lord does not convict your conscience of sin, then you are incapable of stopping yourself from falling into sin and destruction. This demon-possessed man was on his way to a burning hell.

If no one could tame this man then we must ascertain that this man's case was deplorable, despicable, and he was on his way to utter destruction. Oh how blessed it is when the light of the gospel shines on one's face. When the prisoner is released from a state of bondage, there is great joy. Before we accept Jesus as our personal Savior, we are in a state of bondage. We are walking in darkness prior to the entrance of the marvelous light. This man could not help himself, but help was available. Jesus came to Gennesaret to make a difference in this man's life.

IV.UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT, 8:30-39

In verse 30, we ascertain that Jesus posed a question to the demon-possessed man. "What is your name?" Legion, he replied because many demons had gone into him. The bible declares that these demons begged Jesus not to send them to hell at this moment. The demons begged Jesus to send them into the pigs that were feeding on the hillside. The demons knew that when Jesus showed up, he would later show out on behalf of this poor soul. In verse 34, we learn that the demons went into the herd of pigs and they ran down a steep bank into the lake and drowned. Can you imagine what could have happened to this man if Jesus had not showed up and showed out?

In verse 39, we ascertain that the man cured from the demons wanted to go with Jesus. Nevertheless, Jesus instructed the man to return home and tell others about his testimony. The bible tells us that the man went away with a testimony about the wonder working power of Jesus. If the Lord's people would tell about the power of Jesus in our communities, our cities and our country, then our land would be under new management! We can move from serving the devil to serving the Lord! Are you under new management?
