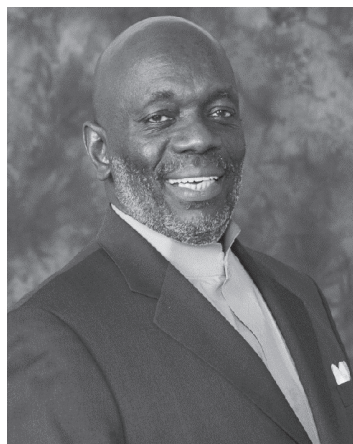
"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Whether you're a pastor or lay leader, you've likely met, or will meet in the future, those who undermine the mission. Please don't hear me saying that the leader is always right. Leaders don't always get it right. Also, not everyone who opposes our vision or ministry practice, is undermining our work. Some folk just disagree with our priorities or our style of leadership. Their voice in the room may be the difference between a good outcome and a great one. But what about those who undermine the wise and careful leadership of the church? What about those who, either through their nescience, pettiness, jealousy or ill will stand in the way of the good work of others.

After more than five decades of leading churches and denominational conventions, I know a few things about underminers. Underminers are people who frustrate or weaken the goals of those entrusted with leadership, whether in a church or one of its ministries. They usually work stealthily, behind the scenes, so they won't be exposed.

Some years back, I was shepherdizing a wonderful congregation. The Lord was adding to our fellowship. Sunday School and Worship attendances were trending upward. Giving was growing. The excitement was palpable! In fact. Not long after we, literally, replaced the worship facility's ceiling and roof, I led the congregation to vote to address other needed repairs to the facility. All seemed to be going well until I got a visit from the chairman of deacons. He told me that he and some unidentified members thought the repairs to the building should take second place to placing a water fountain in the narthex. At that time, we already had one water fountain, and the repairs were aimed at keeping vermin out of the walls of the structure.

I reminded him that he and the other leaders had been present when the church voted to make the repairs. I told him we could address the second water fountain after completing the work the congregation had already approved. He nodded, said he agreed, left my office and began a whispering campaign. He especially targeted



members of my leadership team, including deacons and trustees.

I watched him and a growing number of malcontents attempt to undermine the vision I'd shared with the church. Eventually, he grew bold enough to challenge me in a meeting and, by the grace of God, he and his disgruntled group were soundly rejected by the congregation and, not long thereafter he and a few others left. Afterwards the church grew even more.

There's no one-size-fits-all way to respond when people attempt to undermine your ministry. But here's what I learned.

First, focus on what God has called you to do. Keep preaching the messages God gives you, remain faithful and refuse to become distracted.

Second, understand that it's okay to lose people. Jesus lost people too (John 6:66). The longer you keep divisive people around who don't embrace the church's vision, mission, values and philosophy of ministry, the longer you delay the inevitable. Left unchecked, their divisiveness can metastasize throughout the congregation.

Finally, pray for them. Pray that God changes their hearts, heals whatever is driving their behavior and keeps bitterness from taking root in yours.

Speak Life Thought with Dr. Yolanda G. Butler

"THE PURSUIT OF LIFE"

"But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness." (1 Timothy 6:11)

The pursuit of life can take you down many paths, especially if you have no sense of direction. The blessing for every believer is that the Father laid a clear path for His children to pursue. Biblically speaking, to pursue is to go after something important that aligns with the Father's will. A pursuit is an effort or quest to secure, accomplish, or attain a goal. The Apostle Paul outlined instructions on what not to pursue (1 Timothy 6:3-10). He admonished the believers to stay away from false teachers and those whose main priority is making the dollar. These individuals aim to bring division amongst the body of Christ, cause you to deviate from the faith, and steal your money with their smooth talking and slick schemes.

We must be careful that in our pursuit of life, we are not about promoting covetousness and financial gain but rather godliness and contentment (1 Timothy 6:6). Godliness is living a life of holiness in honor, respect, and reverence towards God; it is attitude and action that is well-pleasing in His eyes. Contentment is a mindset that finds satisfaction and sufficiency in one's circumstance, position in life, or current status. Our focus is to pursue Him

by living a life of godliness with contentment. Faith and trust say that no matter how uncomfortable the situation is, how hard it is, how fearful you might be, or even nervous, you are fully persuaded and confident that the Father is with you. Therefore, you can be content and keep living, pursuing life as He graces you.

"Possessions are only the travelling luggage of time; they are not the stuff of eternity." Paul is not advocating poverty over wealth but rather contentment over covetousness. Don't allow the foolishness of smooth talkers to hinder your faith in God and pursuit of holiness. Every waking day, endeavor to continuously flee (stay away from) foolishness and pursue the six Christian virtues outlined in verse 11 as a way of life that builds faith.

1. **Righteousness** – personal and practical righteous living that brings eternal rewards and blessings; having the mindset to behave in a manner that pleases the Father.
2. **Godliness** - living a life of holiness in honor, respect, and reverence towards God.
3. **Faith** – trust and complete dependability in the sovereignty and character of the Almighty God, the Gospel Message, His Word, and His promises. Faith is the root of walking in righteousness and godliness and the other virtues of love, patience, and meekness.
4. **Love** - the fruit of the character of selfless giving, affection,



and benevolence.

5. **Patience** – a fruit of the Spirit where one is not easily swayed by the greatest of trials, troubles, or tribulations, but patiently waits for a change, shift, or release, trusting in the Father's promises, and gaining strength from His strength to endure to victory.
6. **Meekness** – strength under control, responding to life gently and humbly without confrontation, friction, or conflict.

Fight the good fight of faith. Strive to win this race of the crown of life for a life well lived led by Holy Spirit and walked out in love.

So dear hearts, be determined *"to keep this command without spot or blame until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, which God will bring about in his own time."* (1 Timothy 6:14-15).

A DIAMOND IN THE ROUGH: An Unlikely Urban Farmer Seeks to Help Churches and Community Groups Unlock USDA Opportunities in Fort Worth 76104.

FORT WORTH, TEXAS - When people hear the expression "a diamond in the rough," they often think of someone with extraordinary talent and untapped potential—someone whose value becomes more evident the closer you look.

That is exactly what many pastors and community leaders thought when they first met Diamond Moss, an urban farmer, educator, and USDA representative serving on an important local Farm Service Agency committee.

When Moss accepted an invitation from Pastor Kyev P. Tatum, Sr., Senior Pastor of New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church and President of the Ministers Justice Coalition of Texas, those gathered expected a presentation about farming. What they received was a masterclass in agriculture, food sovereignty, and the many opportunities available through the United States Department of Agriculture.

A graduate of Prairie View A&M University and a fifth-generation Texan, Moss is what some might call gold in the dirt—something precious discovered in an unexpected place. He may dress like a member of Generation Z, but he possesses the heart, wisdom, and vision of a seasoned farmer.

"Diamond is uniquely positioned to bridge the gap between urban agriculture and our communities that are land-rich but cash-flow poor," said Pastor Tatum. "Many of our churches own valuable property that has the potential to become productive community farms. He is helping us see opportunities we never knew existed."

Across many inner-city neighborhoods, often described as food deserts or food apartheid communities, churches possess one resource that



is frequently overlooked—land. With the proper partnerships and USDA support, church campuses can become places where fresh food is grown, children learn healthy living, families gain access to nutritious produce, and neighborhoods begin rebuilding their local food economy.

That vision aligns perfectly with Peace From A Pallet®, Pastor Tatum's Christ-centered framework for community transformation through the Funkytown Food Forest at New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church. The initiative seeks to transform underutilized church property into productive spaces that cultivate faith, food, fellowship, economic opportunity, and environmental stewardship.

As founder of AfroGreen'D Gardening, Moss has devoted his work to teaching food sovereignty, environmental justice, and sustainable agriculture throughout Fort Worth. Raised in the Highland Hills neighborhood, he understands firsthand the challenges many communities face in accessing fresh, healthy food.

Operating under the motto "Seed Now, Eat Later," AfroGreen'D empowers residents to grow their own food, reduce dependence on grocery stores, recycle food waste into

compost, decrease landfill waste, and improve both physical and mental health through gardening. Moss often describes gardening as a source of "organic mental relief," emphasizing that cultivating the soil can also cultivate healthier lives.

His impact extends into Fort Worth ISD, where AfroGreen'D partners with leadership academies to educate hundreds of students about sustainable agriculture, healthy living, and environmental responsibility. Through weekly volunteer opportunities and educational workshops at Timberview Farmstead and other urban farming sites, Moss continues inspiring the next generation of growers and community leaders.

His message is simple but profound:

"Just allowing ourselves to garden and provide for our community—to reuse, recycle, and replenish what we use in everyday life—that will help with climate change."

His work could not come at a more critical time.

According to a 2019 UT Southwestern Medical Center study, Fort Worth's 76104 ZIP code has the lowest life expectancy in Texas—just 66.7 years. Increasing access to healthy food, improving nutrition, and reconnecting neighborhoods with local agriculture are essential steps toward changing those outcomes.

Diamond Moss is not new to this—he is true to this.

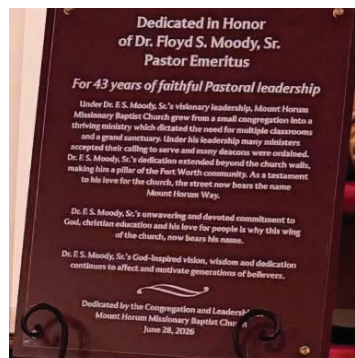
And with the support of local churches, community organizations, and committed partners, the future looks brighter because one diamond in the rough is helping others discover the hidden treasures already planted within their own communities.

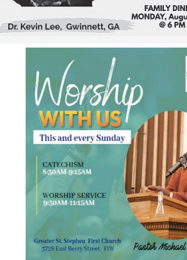

The Choir Never Left by Vincent Bohanan

I've been seeing people lately saying, "The choir is coming back!" Maybe I've been on a different planet... but the choir never left.



Have there been seasons where choirs and choir music were pushed to the background? Absolutely. There were times when gatekeepers, trends, and industry preferences shifted the spotlight elsewhere. But even during those seasons, choir directors, musicians, singers, and churches remained faithful. We kept rehearsing. We kept recording. We kept traveling. We kept ministering. We never stopped believing in the power of the choir.

One thing that has always bothered me is the tendency to elevate one expression of gospel music and diminishing another. Why does one style have to "die" for another to "live"? Why can't they all coexist? Solo artists, praise teams, worship collectives,

quartets, ensembles, traditional choirs, and contemporary choirs all have a place in the Kingdom.

While I appreciate seeing choirs receive renewed attention, many of us who have dedicated our lives to choir ministry can't help but smile because... we've been here the whole time. We didn't stop because they weren't the industry's focus. We continued the work when it wasn't popular, when it wasn't profitable, and when it wasn't trending.

To every choir leader and choir member, Your consistency helped preserve a sound that has carried generations, and because of that faithfulness, a new generation gets to experience the power of the choir.
