





"The LEADER'S EDGE" by dr. michael bell

As I prepare for 2018, I'm taking a personal refresher course in **communication**. Because communication is a core leadership function, I'm studying everything I can about how to improve as a communicator. Effective communication and effective leadership are go hand in glove.

I honestly don't remember where I first read this quote, but some wise somebody said, "Leadership requires communication like a flame requires oxygen." By communication, I'm not talking about the public speaking; I'm not referring to the preached word. I'm talking about leadership communication, the kind of communication that can help or hinder your Church's attempts to row together in the same direction. Good communication is critical to ministry effectiveness and to your personal credibility as a leader.

Of course, the most necessary function of communication within an organization, especially the local Church, is to inform, persuade and motivate. Successful entities communicate intentionally because they recognize that when leadership fails to communicate effectively, issues arise, conflict presents itself and organizational momentum slows to a crawl or ceases altogether.

There are *at least* four communication mistakes Churches make:

1. Church leaders assume people care about what we have to say. Frankly, they don't. The first step in improving our communication is to realize people generally don't care about what we have to say. People care about themselves! Even the most spiritual in our congregations want to be communicated about things that interest them, in a way that's convenient for them, at a time that's best for them.

Our job is not to make them want to come around to our way of communicating or to make them want to hear what we want to say. Our job is to speak their language. Our job is to remove obstacles and barriers to their receiving the message they care about hearing. Our job is to go out and communicate where they are gathering instead of expecting people to come to us to get information.

2. **No communication.** Strother Martin's (*March 26, 1919 – August 1, 1980*) character in the



1967 film Cool Hand Luke said to Paul Newman's (January 26, 1925 September 26, 2008) character, "What we've got here is failure to communicate." In the hustle and bustle of the day, it can be easy to forget that information we are gathering in everything we do should be shared with the people we're assigned to lead. For example, if the Church leadership team is discussing a new Church program, ministry or initiative, it's their responsibility to think through who will be impacted by this decision and what information needs to be shared before the program is launched.

3. A poor communication process. Communication can make or break a ministry or even a Church. Effective communication between Church leaders, especially, the Pastor, can help the Church solve problems and accomplish her goals. Poor communication cripples ministries, committees, and Churches, creating even more problems and preventing them from focusing on the goals they've set. It's imperative to establish a predictable process for sharing information with congregants!

4. **Not Clarifying Action Steps.** You must have a have clear callaton-action on *every* communication exchange! It's a mistake to communicate all sorts of details but not explain what you want the people to do. Neglecting to include next actions is a major mistake for churches. Tell your people what the next step is!

There's much more I want to communicate with you about the priority of communication. We'll go deeper next month. Blessings on your ministry to the glory of God.

"Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Life of Change"

"Anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! All this is a gift from God." (1 Cor 5:17-18b NLT)

What a blessing to know that once your sins are forgiven, you can make a fresh start into something new. Salvation is a gift that affords us the opportunity to hit the refresh button in our lives. Accepting Jesus Christ into our hearts gives us new meaning, new hope, new purpose, new direction, and a new destiny. Your life literally becomes marked for change.

The beginning of a new year marks the beginning of a fresh phase in your life. Each month is a chapter to be written based on how you live it out. Change means to arrive at a fresh phase. Biblically speaking, change is a supernatural shifting by the divine will of God where you move from one position to another. This is known as a changeover. We see this demonstrated in the life of Abraham and his journeys, Elijah when he was led to the Zarephath widow to sustain him, Deacon Philip being promoted to Evangelist Philip, and the Pharisee Saul radically changed into the Apostle Paul. With these and so many other Biblical examples, we see that change is something we should not be afraid to yield to. Just what will change do for you?

Change will shift your economic system. This is done through a system of sowing and reaping in time, money, resources, and service unto God. (Gal 6:7-9) Change will shift your prayer life. This is done through prayers, petitions, and supplications. Jacob wrestled with God until He was blessed and became Israel, one who struggles with God (Gen. 32:28)

Change will shift your fasting regimen. This is done to get you in position to hear from God. (Joel 2:12-13) It also develops your character and relationship towards others. As you train your appetite to change so do you hunger and thirst after righteousness. Change will shift your endurance. This is strength to hold on. Paul said to endure hardness (troubles) as a good soldier. (2 Tim. 2:3) This is being able to stand and remain even under pressure. When situations are hard, you have the endurance to bravely bear them.

Change will shift your praise. When Gideon's army was reduced to 300 to fight against 135,000, his praise shifted. When Hannah was barren, she prayed. God released change in her life and her praise shifted even before she conceived. When Paul and Silas were wrongfully beaten and thrown in prison, their praise shifted.

If God says change, that means every aspect and fiber of who you



are must change. He would not tell you to change if He did not have a Kingdom agenda in mind. Paul experienced a change in his life that brought forth a radical change that paved the way for souls to be won for the Kingdom. The change God is ushering you and I through has a purpose and that is to pave the way for souls to be won for the Kingdom. So dear hears, stay determined to change and let us win souls for Christ in 2019!





GOING FORWARD

Genesis 12:1-7

I. INTRODUCTION

When we encounter a situation or circumstance that is unfamiliar, uninhabited, or unexplored, we embark upon unchartered waters. Sometimes unchartered waters have unchartered rocky places in life. If you hit one of these rocky places, we know that sailing can get tough. Yet, the Christian possesses some help for tomorrow's challenges. According to Romans 8:26-28, we are encouraged with the words that tell us, "26 In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. 27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God. 28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, whohave been called according to his purpose."

As we set sail for a New Year, we have some things that must change. You may have gone through some major hurts or disappointments in 2018. Now is the time to take a deep breath, relax and let it go. We must let go of past hurts, injustices, jealousies, and broken relationships. Yesterday will keep you hung up but tomorrow will open a new door of opportunities. Yet, we must never let success go to our heads or allow failure to get to our hearts.

Facing the future can be inspiring, challenging, and exciting. Nevertheless, we should examine our biblical examples of faith that can help us deal with the uncertainties of life. For instance, in Hebrews 11:7, the bible tells us that Noah prepared an ark for the saving of his family because he was moved by godly fear.Let's delve into the scriptures to understand how to deal with unchartered

II. THE CALL TO COME OUT, v.1-3

According to verse 1, the Lord gives a command to Abraham. God commands Abraham to get out of his country. We may observe that Abraham's country was full of idolatry and constant temptations. It was not a place conducive to righteous living. Today, we must acknowledge that we too must let go of some things in our lives. It is good to remember God's goodness but we must move forward. The bible tells us that we are born to grow. It is not wise to keep looking in the rear view mirror of an automobile but we must look forward and drive toward our destina-

Abraham was commanded to leave familiar surroundings and embrace new territory. 2016 is gone and we must view the world with a positive perspective. The command to Abraham to leave Haran is similar to the gospel call. We must leave our old lust and sinful ways and commit our way unto the Lord. The bible teaches



us to acknowledge the Lord and He will direct our paths. Since the Lord is our navigator in this world of uncertainty, we have a compass that can give us joy for the iourney.

Our country is dear to us and our kindred are dearer. Yet our love for the Lord must exceed all (Lu. 14:26). We must love them less than Christ, and hate them in comparison with Him. Natural affection must give way to divine grace. We should walk in the light of gospel grace. There is a danger in looking back. Lot's wife can tell you the danger of looking back. We must move at the Lord's command. When the Lord tells us to go, we must go. Our God does not always tell us the details when He issues a command. The Lord does not say in verse 1, "It is a land that I will give thee," but merely, "a land that I will show thee." Nor does he tell him what land it was, nor what kind of land: but he must follow God with an implicit faith, and take God at His Word. We must deal with God upon trust. We must quit the things that are seen for things that are not seen.

III. COOPERATION WITH THE CALL, v.4-6

Since the just shall live by faith, we are taught to live in a continual dependence upon His direction. We must live with our eves towards Him. Abraham was commanded to leave his kindred and go to a place that the Lord would show him. The Lord's command placed Abraham in a vulnerable position yet Abraham obeyed God. We are told that Abraham was seventy-five years old at the time of his call.

When we look at the examples of faith in Hebrews 11:8-9, we find that Abraham went out not knowing where he was going. Yet, we find that he was looking for a builder and maker who is God. When we choose to follow the Lord's precepts, the Lord will reward us. Abraham was rewarded because the Lord blessed his seed with a promise. The Lord told Abraham that He would bless him to be a great nation. It is recorded in the Hall of Faith, that Abraham was blessed. When 2019 arrives, will we obey the Lord so that the blessings of heaven can fall fresh on us? Or will we live a defeated lifestyle in 2019? We can claim the blessings of the promise if we cooperate with the gospel call.

Abraham obeyed God in a speedily fashion and without delay. The bible does not state that Abraham questioned God upon this command. Without dispute,

Abraham went but knowing whom he followed and under whose direction he

As we set out for success on this New Year, let us remember the example of Abraham. The Lord has not given us every detail of the journey but we are guaranteed a successful sail if we trust in the Lord. If we are going to be successful this year, we must persevere to the end. We must reach forth to those things that are before us. When we choose to undertake God's commandments we will certainly succeed, and end with comfort

IV. CONSTANT PRACTICE, v.7

When the Lord appeared to Abraham, he decided to build an altar with an eye of faith. The building of an altar is a representation of Abraham communicating with the Lord and keeping up the correspondence with heaven. Abraham acknowledged, with thankfulness God's kindness to him in making him that gracious visit and promise. An active believer can heartily bless God for a promise of things that he cannot see and build an altar to the Lord.

As Abraham's constant practice; he set up, and kept up the worship of God in his family. The example of worship by Abraham after his conversation with the Lord is something that every household should admonish and keep up. When one decides to honor the Lord, the Lord will honor that person with the promise. We must obey God like Abraham and then we must worship and wait on the promise. Since the victory is already won, we must uphold our end and walk in faith.

For he not only minded the ceremonial part of religion, the offering of sacrifice, but Abraham made a conscientious effort to call upon the name of the Lord. The Lord is pleased when we act in faith and continue in fellowship with Him. This should be our constant practice in 2019. The way of family worship is a good old way, is no novel invention, but the ancient usage of all the saints. Abram was very rich and had a largeunsettled family in the midst of enemies. Yet, wherever he pitched his tent, he built an altar. Wherever we go in 2019. let us not fail to worship the Lord for all of His many benefits.
