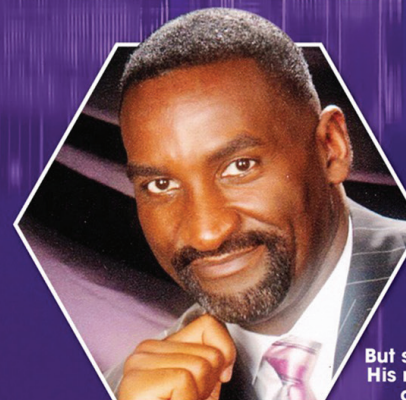

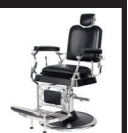

## "The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Planning for the New Year, particularly the first year of a new decade, isn't easy. If it was, every Church would do it. Exactly why do Churches struggle to get into the planning groove? For one thing, some pastors and leadership teams don't know how or aren't particularly gifted in that area. Others have given up on planning and literally fly or live by the "seat of their pants." And, still others feel so completely overwhelmed by ministry's constant urgencies that planning is minimized in importance or neglected altogether. What's really unfortunate is that planning for the year might be the most beneficial thing you can do. Hungarian-American psychologist Mihaly Csikszentmihalyi, who is the Distinguished Professor of Psychology and Management at Claremont Graduate University, located in the Golden State, is quoted as saying, **"Goals transform a random walk into a chase."** For the Church, this means that setting goals can help your congregation pursue its God-ordained mission with even more passion and greater clarity.

But, how do you do Church planning when you've already begun the year you're planning for? I mean, it's January already and neither you or your leadership team are quite sure where y'all are headed.

**First, set some goals for the first quarter (January-March).** What are some special days on the calendar you should be aware of? January 19th is the Sunday immediately preceding the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday. Will your Church give tribute to Dr. King's life and legacy? February is African American history month. Does that have any significance for your congregation? What about February 26th, Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of the Season of Lent?

**What are your first quarter goals?** Goal setting is the nuts and bolts of transforming potentiality into actuality. Inspirational and motivational speaker Mark Victor Hansen, founder and co-creator of the "Chicken Soup for the Soul" book se-



ries, argues that **"You'll fail at a 100% of the goals you don't set."**

**Second, once you've set your goal(s), the next step is to cultivate objectives or conceive a plan of action for each target.** List various steps that will help you reach your goal(s). What's your average worship attendance? And, if you don't keep count, then, why not? Scripture is clear how many were added to the Church on the Day of Pentecost. In Numbers 1:1-3, not long after Israel's escape from Egyptian hegemony, God told Moses to count the people by tribe to determine the number of Jewish men 20 years and older who could serve in the military. How about Gideon's 300? It's simple: **we count people because people count! What's your Church action plan for reaching more people for Christ?**

**What about your Church budget?** How much was given through your Church last year? How much was spent? What is your Church's weekly projected receipts? How much does it take to fund your Church's Mission and Ministries? **What's the action plan for increasing your Church budget receipts?**

Keep this thought before you: **your goal is the destination; your action plan is the map that tells how to get there.**

Let's talk some more next month.

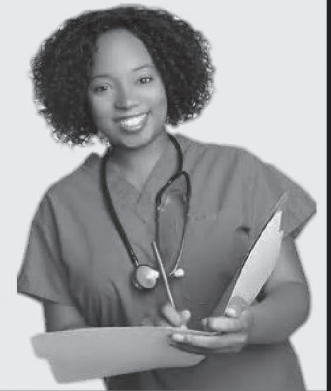

## "Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

### A Life Worth Living

*"I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me." (Galatians 3:20)*

Recently I was awakened from a dream with a clear exhortation from the Holy Ghost to, "Tell my people to **"LIVE!"** In all your doing, don't forget how to LIVE. In all your labor, don't forget how to LIVE. You do this by learning to LIVE in and for God. So many people are unhappy afraid, and ashamed, and embarrassed to admit it. Existing but forgot how to LIVE. I want to encourage you for 2020 to make a commitment to God to LIVE.

To live means you must put away some things or "crucify," meaning become utterly separated, turned off, or friendless from a former habit. Crucify sin, that which offends God; shame (embarrassment); and, the guilt of failure and hurt (mental and physical injury, pain, and distress).

To live means Christ, the Greater Power, lives in you. *"... nevertheless I live, yet not I, but Christ lives in me."* You will never find true love, joy and happiness apart from God. You can search all over, do whatever

appeases the flesh, but it will not bring you true fulfillment and purpose. Apart from God you will experience emptiness, no peace, whirlwind of emotions, and brokenness, ever searching to fill in the gaps.

To live means you must establish focused priorities. *"...and the life which I now live in the flesh, I live by faith..."* Now living is focused living. It is good to set goals such as marriage, degree, ministry, children, etc. but all priorities should be Christ-centered. Impulsive and emotional decisions, such as unhealthy relationships, immoral living, lustful purchases, pull you away from God.

To live means you must walk in Love, Intimacy, Victory and Excellence. *"...the son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me."*

**Love** - Love God first by surrendering you to Him (See Matt. 22:37-40)

**Intimacy** - develop an intimate relationship with God that ignites passion, dreams, and desires within you. *"He restores and revives my life."* (Ps. 23:3)

**Victorious** - you are victorious no matter what comes up against you. *"Everyone born of God is victorious and overcomes the world..."* (1 John 5:4)

**Excellency** - in everything you do, do it with excellency. Even



if you fail, get back up and try again. Try something different. Don't die in the process. (See Col. 3:23-24)

Why Live? So you can live again as God intended through Christ, active, blessed, endless in the Kingdom of God. *"Wage of sin is death but the gift of God is eternal life."* (Rom. 6:23)

Jesus Christ paid the price for the penalty of sin giving us opportunity to be free. When you acknowledge you are a sinner, accept that Jesus took your place for death, conquered death, rose from the grave with all power and your freedom, you become united with Him to LIVE. You were meant to be more than a body with a dead battery. You have been called to LIVE and it begins in Christ. So dear hearts, from this day forward be determined to LIVE!

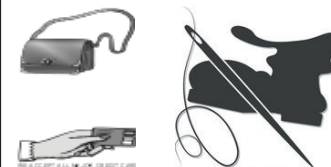

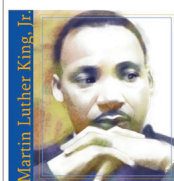

## The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word...

### New Opportunity

Ephesians 5:15-17

#### 1. Introduction

Each year represents a new opportunity to do it all over again. Aren't you glad that you have been favored? There are some things that we as Christians should overcome in our lives. Since the Lord has given us another chance, we should make the best out of 2020. On one occasion, Jesus' disciples inquired as to what is the greatest commandment. Jesus informed the disciples that love is the greatest of all the commandments. Love is one common denominator that should unify all Christians. Love is the principle disposition that we should display because we are children of the Lord.

When we accept Jesus as our personal Savior, we enter into a relationship with the Lord. It is very unseemly that one should stay the same. There is an old adage within the church, "I looked at my hands and my hands looked new." "I looked at my feet and they did too." When children are born into the world, there is a great likelihood that they will exhibit some of the characteristics of their parents. Some children come from good parents who are long-suffering, kind, gentle, and loving. These are godly traits that every Christian should endeavor to possess. Do you encourage your children and grandchildren in the ways of the Lord? All Christians should strive to encourage everyone to live holy. As children of God, we are encouraged to be imitators of Christ. What attribute are you willing to work on during the New Year? Do you have enough love in your heart to make a difference in the world? Are you walking in the light rather than in the former darkness?

As we take a telescopic view of Ephesians 5, we find that we are encouraged to be followers of God. Before the Holy Spirit entered into our hearts, we were on our way to a burning hell. Since the Lord has rescued us from danger, we have a responsibility to walk in the light and not in darkness. As Christians, we should represent our Lord in our actions and the way we live. Is there something holding you back from becoming all you can be for Christ in 2020? We have a new opportunity in 2020 to get it right with the Lord. The things that tripped you up in 2019, should not trip you up in 2020.

The Word of God informs the believer that we should put aside fornication and all uncleanness. Filthy lusts must be suppressed. Is there anyone that is struggling with pornography? Is there anyone that is struggling with a wandering eye of lust? Do you have an insatiable love for the riches of this world? Is there anyone suffering with the sin of covetousness? We need to live in a way so that the world will know that we are not idol worshippers. These were some of the sins that the Gentile church was struggling with at Ephesus. The apostle Paul wrote to the Ephesians to inform them that there is a great danger in living the old life. The wrath of God will come upon the children of disobedience. As we approach the text, we will find that the Apostle Paul has outlined some responsibilities for those living the new life.

#### 2. Walking in the Right Way, v.15

We should look carefully how we should walk. We should not walk as unwise but



as wise servants. As believers in Christ, we have an obligation to possess what we profess. If we profess to be Christians, we should possess some Christian attributes. If we are to be helpful to the body of Christ in 2020, we should have lives that provide an example to a lost world. We cannot say, "Do as I say and not what I do?" The believer's testimony can make a more impressive impact if what I say lines up with what I do. We must walk circumspectively in this world by walking as the Lord requires. To walk circumspectively refers to one that is walking accurately or exactly in the right way. No one can walk in the right way if they do not allow the Holy Spirit to lead and guide them in their conduct.

We should not walk as fools because a fool has no understanding of their duty. A fool does not have any regard for the destiny of their soul but is like the rich man in Luke 12:13-21. In verse 18, the rich man said that I will tear down my barns and build bigger barns. To add insult to injury, the rich man said that "I will say to my soul, soul take it easy and eat, drink and be merry." Our Lord God said unto him, "Thou fool, this night thy soul shall be required of thee, and then whose shall those things belong to? The fact about life is that we will leave stuff or stuff will leave us. Nevertheless, we need to send up some timber because man does not know the hour that the Lord will return. We cannot fall into a state of ease because danger lies at our doorstep. We are taught by the Word of God to walk in the right way!

The Word of God tells us that it is required of a steward to be found faithful unto death. We must govern our own behavior and conduct before we can help someone else that is struggling with behavioral issues. Jesus said on one occasion, "How can you take the mote out of your brother's eye when there is a beam in yours?" Listen, you cannot help someone see the light when you are walking in darkness. Let the light shine in your lives so that your Father might be glorified in heaven.

#### 3. Making the Best Use of Time v. 16

In verse 16, Paul informs the church at Ephesus that we should redeem the time because the days are evil. The statement is a metaphor because it is taken from merchants and traders who diligently observe and improve the seasons for merchandise and trade. It is a great part of Christian wisdom to redeem the time. Good Christians must be good managers of their time. We must take care to improve the use of our allotted time for the best of purposes. We must watch against temptations by doing well while it is in the power of our hands. We must make the best use of our time by filling it up with proper employment. Are you serving the Lord in a way that He is pleased?

When we make the most out of our time, we will find that this will help to preserve us from sin. It has been said that an idle mind is the devil's workshop. It is good to be busy for kingdom-building work. Since no one knows when the Lord will do a roll call, it behooves every Christian to be about their Father's business. We should endeavor in 2020 to make the best use out of our current season of grace. Don't let 2020 slip out without you doing more for the Lord. It is my belief that we should get sweeter as the day moves on. Life should not make us bitter but life should make us better. Will you be better in 2020? Our time is a talent given us by God for some good end. We do not want to be like the unjust steward in the bible. It is the obligation of every Christian to improve upon the things that God has invested in them. Do you want to make good use of God's investment in your life? Or are you willing to go along just to get along? If a behavior is wrong, we should demonstrate the right way by living in the Light.

Sin is the great enemy of the church. A life is lost when it is not employed according to the Creator's design. Are you living out your God-given purpose? Are you using the gifts and the talents that the Lord God has given you? If we have lost time in 2019, we must endeavor to redeem it by doubling our diligence in doing our Christian duty in 2020.

#### 4. Don't Neglect Your Duty, v. 17

Times will get worse but the Christian should not be unwise. There may come a time when one cannot do what they would like to do because the opportunity is not there. We have to make the best out of the time that we have. The evil days will come. We cannot be ignorant of our duty and negligent about our souls. It is imperative that we understand the will of God for our lives. We should study and consider God's will for our lives. When we consider the will of God, we will be able to accurately determine our duty. If we are ignorant of our duty and show neglect for our souls, we give evidence of foolish behavior. An acquaintance with the will of God and careful compliance will speak volumes for the Christian's life. As we face an uncertain tomorrow, let's remember that what the Lord has done for others, he can do for you. We have many examples of how servants of God have been victorious in the bible. We can be victorious disciples if we walk in the Light of God's Word and not become entangled with the world's ideology. Keep on working for the Lord and please note that the Lord is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Let's do better in 2020! Let's put aside those things that easily beset us and run this race of faith!

Sponsored by the ImaniMD Health Ministry, the purpose of this health summit is to bring citywide stakeholders together to develop a comprehensive coherent approach to reduce the stigma of mental health issues and increase access to care for the African-American community.

Those community conditions, she said, include things like living in "challenging neighborhoods," not having stable housing or living below the poverty line. Although these factors increase the likelihood of having mental health challenges, she added, only 25 percent of African-Americans will seek mental health care compared to 40 percent of their white counterparts.

"So, we recognize that in order to improve and enhance overall wellness in this specific population that we have to do a better job of educating and creating opportunities for awareness," Coffee said.

## New Year's Resolutions

"I never make New Year's Resolutions, anymore," the man told me, "I never keep them, anyway." I can remember all too many resolutions I've made and let slip away, too. But I believe New Year's resolutions are worth making. Let me tell you why.

First, we all need changes. Some we find very hard to admit to ourselves. I've heard people who say, "I have no regrets about my life. If I had it to do over, I'd do it the same way again." But that attitude is way too blind and self-serving so far as I'm concerned. There is great power in confession--to ourselves, to God, to others. Owning up to our failures is the first, painful step on the road to something better.

Second, when we change calendars is a good time for reassessment. How did last year go? What do I want to do differently this year? This time of year always reminds me of a passage of scripture, better understood by farmers than suburbanites: "Break up your unplowed ground, and do not sow among thorns" (Jer 4:3). It makes sense. The more land you put into production, the more prosperous you'll be. But some of us are stupid enough to try to sow seeds in land overrun by star thistle without breaking up the soil and taking care

to root out the thorns as they come up. Call it laziness. Call it stupidity.

Let me ask you a serious question. What percentage of your life is producing something of value to God? How much "unplowed ground" do you have that ought to be broken up in this coming year and made useful? Reassessment. The brink of a new year is a good time for reassessment.

Third, New Year's is an excellent time for mid-course corrections. Sure, we might fail in what we set out to do, but if we fail to plan, the old saw goes, then we plan to fail. If you're so fearful of failure that you never set up your row of tin cans to shoot at, you're not very likely to hit any at all. Failure is not the end. For the person who determines to learn from it, failure is a friend.

One of my heroes in the Bible is the Apostle Paul. Talk about failure! Throughout his life he was opposed, persecuted, shipwrecked, stoned and left for dead, deserted by trusted co-workers, slandered, and scorned. Sometimes it seemed that projects to which he had devoted years were turning to dust before his eyes. But during from one of his stints in prison, we can see from one of his letters an unwillingness to quit. "Forgetting what is behind," he wrote, "and straining toward what is ahead, I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me

heavenward in Christ Jesus" (Phil 3:13-14, NIV) No wonder he made a mark on his world. He stopped looking back, and looked forward instead. He didn't let the fear of failure keep him from trying again.

Fourth, New Year's is a time to learn to rely more heavily on the grace of God. Now I've met a few self-made men and women and so have you, but so often these people seem proud and driven. There is another way: beginning to trust in God's help. One more secret from the Apostle Paul: "I can do everything through Him who gives me strength," he said (Phil 4:13, NIV). And God's strength saw him through a lot--through pain, through joy, and through accomplishment.

If this last year, you didn't practice relying on the Lord as much as you should have, there is no time like the present to make a New Year's resolution. In fact, why don't you say a short prayer right now--use these words if you like: "Dear God, I want the new year to be different for me." Now spell out in prayer some of the changes you'd like to see. And close this way: "Lord Jesus, I know that I'm going to need a lot of help for this. So right now I place myself in your hands. Help me to receive Your strength. Amen." Good. Now you've got a much better chance of a Happy New Year.
