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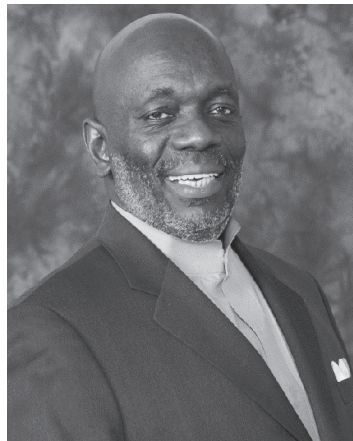
## "The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

The Church isn't built on the shoulders of one person, but through the shared commitment and faithful service of many people working together. God's design for ministry has always included partnership, cooperation, and mutual support. Just as the human body functions best when every part works together in harmony, the Church is strongest when her members unite around a common purpose, shared vision and collective commitment. When people pray together, serve together, and labor together, ministry becomes more effective, more meaningful, and more transformative.

You've heard the saying, "Teamwork makes the dream work." There's real wisdom in that statement. Nobody can do ministry alone, and healthy ministry teams are often the heartbeat of a healthy Church. The phrase "one another" or "each other" appears nearly one hundred times in the New Testament, reminding us that God never intended for us to live, serve or grow in isolation. From Moses and Aaron to Jesus and the disciples, to Paul and his ministry partners, the Bible consistently shows God using teams, groups and partnerships to accomplish Kingdom work.

Ministry Teams exist to help meet the ongoing ministry needs of the Church through people who are willing to serve and committed to doing the work. These teams are made up of volunteers who have a passion for serving in a particular area of ministry, whether it's Youth & Children's Ministry, Women's Ministry, Men's Ministry, outreach, hospitality, worship, or another area of service and outreach. Every team plays an important role in strengthening the life of the Church and helping us carry out our mission with excellence, compassion and empathy.

In the life of the Church, effective teamwork plays a vital role in fulfilling the mission and serving the congregation well. But even faithful ministry teams can face challenges that weaken their effectiveness and strain relationships. Let's consider three common dysfunctions that can quietly undermine a ministry team.



The first dysfunction is **vagueness about what a ministry is trying to accomplish.** There's an old saying that a dog who chases two rabbits will catch neither. When ministry team members are working in different directions, they'll likely not get the desired results. Having a clear mission, vision, and values are key to strengthening ministry teams. So is recruiting people who buy into this mission, vision, and set of core values.

The second dysfunction is **ignoring the need to meet and connect.** Ministry teams often fall into the trap of prioritizing urgent tasks over connection. When a team ignores the need to regularly gather and connect, it cripples the foundational trust required to function effectively. Church ministry teams connect through a blend of regular in-person meetings, casual social outings, and virtual collaboration.

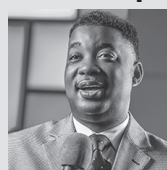
The third dysfunction is **the avoidance of accountability.** Accountability is critical in Church leadership to ensure that responsibilities are fulfilled and expectations are met. The gospel isn't honored by sloppy saints or disorganized teams. When individuals on the team are unwilling to hold each other accountable in their actions, the result is inconsistency and low standards.

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## Speak Life Thought

### "A Life to Stand in Faith"

*13 But Moses told the people, "Don't be afraid. Just stand still and watch the Lord rescue you today. The Egyptians you see today will never be seen again. 14 The Lord himself will fight for you. Just stay calm." (Exodus 14:13-14 NLT)*

I can recall one summer, our HVAC went out. The soonest a tech could come out was in about three days. Without air conditioning during a Texas summer, the house temperature could quickly increase from 68 to 93, making it very uncomfortable. No matter how much we tried to use ceiling fans, upright fans, and open windows, there was little to no relief, nothing but hot air. The tech couldn't arrive fast enough, and when he did, it was discovered we needed a new unit, which means a few more days of discomfort. We just had to hold out and stand until change came.

The word stand is a highly dynamic word, meaning to support oneself on one's feet in an upright, vertical position. It also means to successfully resist or tolerate something; to be situated or located in a specific spot; and a firmly held attitude or defensive effort regarding a specific issue.

It seems like when the temperature of life gets really hot, it becomes almost unbearable and uncomfortable to stand. It makes you irritable, makes it difficult to sleep, and makes it difficult to find

comfort, let alone see a way out. Such is the case with the Israelites as they stood pinned between the Red Sea and hostile Egyptian warriors. Their first reaction was to stand in panic and fear, followed by complaints about leadership decision-making.

The Israelites needed to be reminded that the Father is a Promise-keeper. If He spoke it, rest assured it shall come to pass. Moses demonstrated the right attitude to stand in faith when he encouraged the Israelites not to be afraid, but rather to stand still and watch the Father's delivering power manifest. This is the attitude we must develop when we find ourselves facing a rock in a hard place. Remember the promises the Father spoke over your life. Reflect upon the truth of His Word. Believe in His character. These are faith points that you can stand on.

As you begin to stand in faith, you can see that the Father will fight the battle. If you believe that He is more than able to fight the giants in your life, then you should have no problem with His next directive—"hold your peace!" If you are standing in faith, then quiet your mind and watch Him work. Let Him be the Almighty God in your life who has declared He will get the glory and honor. Joseph said it plainly, "20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good. He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people." (Genesis 50:20 NLT).

Why is the Father emphasizing that I only need to be stand and



be still? He is trying to show you that if you trust Him, He will carry you through to victory. If you draw closer to Him in faith, He will draw even closer to you. He will carry you in love in hurtful times. He will carry you in peace through scary times. He will carry you in joy in times of sorrow. He will carry you in patience through your doubtful seasons. He will carry you gently and never drop you. He will gracefully carry you even when you can't carry yourself. He will mercifully carry you even in your anger. Most importantly, the Father is trying to destroy what is chasing you so you can move forward to what He promised.

So dear hearts, be determined to live a life of faith that unapologetically will stand on a sure foundation established by God that is unshakable, unwavering, and unbreakable.

## The historic Mount Gilead Baptist Church, Downtown Fort Worth closes her location after over 150 Years of service



Mount Gilead Baptist Church is Fort Worth's oldest African-American Baptist congregation, founded in 1875 by 12 formerly enslaved people. It has been called the "mother church" because many other African-American Baptist churches in the city trace their origins to this historic church.

The congregation met at several locations before constructing its current building in 1912-1913. The Neoclassical-style sanctuary at 600 Grove Street was designed by Fort Worth architects Sanguinet & Staats (with contributing architect W.A. Rayfield) and built by contractors J.W.O. Guinn and B.W. Owens. The design includ-

ed a pedimented entrance, stained glass dome, and a raised basement with a day nursery, library, gymnasium, and an indoor swimming pool — a rare amenity for African Americans at the time.

For generations, Mount Gilead served as a central hub for Fort Worth's Black community, offering not only worship but also job skills training, safe spaces for social gatherings, and a variety of community events such as Easter egg hunts, youth dance ministry, graduation recognitions, and men's ministry outings. It was a place where families could find both spiritual and civic support.

The church is recognized as Highly Significant Endangered Landmark by the City of Fort Worth Architecture in Fort Worth. Its architecture reflects both religious and civic importance, with features like stained glass and a prominent portico that have been preserved despite alterations over

time.

By the 2020s, the congregation faced declining membership, deferred maintenance, and costly repairs. In 2025, members voted to sell the historic building after fundraising efforts fell short of covering major upgrades to HVAC, plumbing, and accessibility. The sale, approved by a 19-4 vote, was intended to secure a smaller, more sustainable home while preserving the church's name and ministries.

Mount Gilead was to hold its final service after 150 years of ministry on the 5th Sunday in May 2026, marking the end of its long-standing presence in downtown. Members expressed deep emotional ties to the building, recalling decades of worship, family life, and community service.

In summary: Mount Gilead Baptist Church's history spans over 150 years of faith, community leadership, and architectural heritage, making it a cornerstone of Fort Worth's African-American heritage before its closure.

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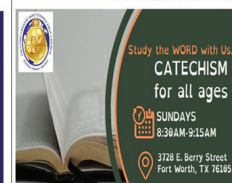
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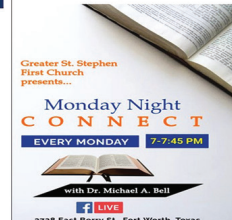

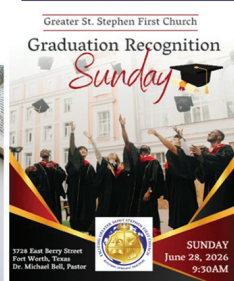


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## Why There Are So Many Churches

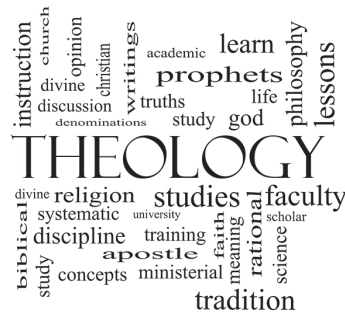
The existence of hundreds of churches worldwide is the result of historical, cultural, theological, and practical factors that have shaped Christianity over centuries.

### 1. Early Church Unity and Later Divergence

In the first century, the early Church was united under core beliefs—faith in Jesus Christ and His resurrection—without formal denominations. Local congregations worshipped together, shared resources, and followed the apostles' teaching (Acts 2:42). However, differences in interpretation, cultural context, and leadership styles began to emerge even then.

### 2. Interpretive Differences in Scripture

While all Christian groups affirm the authority of Scripture, they may differ on how to interpret it. Some emphasize literal readings, others historical context, and others symbolic meanings. Differences often arise on secondary doctrines—such



as baptism, church governance, or the role of spiritual gifts—without contradicting core beliefs.

### 3. Historical and Political Influences

Major events shaped church divisions:

Ecumenical Councils (e.g., Nicaea 325, Chalcedon 451) defined orthodox teachings but also highlighted divisions over Christ's nature.

The Great Schism (1054) split the Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox Churches over theology and culture.

The Protestant Reformation (16th century) broke from the Catholic Church over issues like salvation by grace alone, Scripture alone, and the role of tradition, leading to Lutherans, Anglicans, Presbyterians, Baptists, Methodists, and many others.

### 4. Cultural and Worship Preferences

Over time, churches adapted to local cultures, languages, and worship styles. Some emphasize liturgical traditions, others focus on preaching and evangelism, and others prioritize community outreach or missionary work.

### 5. Growth of Christianity

With about one-third of the world's population being Christian and the number growing, the diversity of churches reflects the global spread of the faith. Even underground or house churches count as part of the "body of Christ" (Ephesians 4:4).

### 6. Theological and Practical Latitude

While Jesus spoke of "my church" (Matthew 16:18), the New Testament also calls believers to unity (1 Corinthians 1:10). Beyond essential doctrines, there is room for different ways of worship, discipline, and mission focus, leading to many "flavors" of Christianity.

#### In summary:

We have so many churches because Christianity began as a unified movement but evolved through differences in interpretation, cultural adaptation, historical events, and practical worship styles. These variations exist within the belief that Jesus is Lord and Savior, but they reflect how believers seek to live out their faith in diverse contexts.
