"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Leadership guru John Maxwell writes in his too thin volume, *The 21 Indispensable Qualities of a Leader*, "Knowing how to lead is only half the battle. Understanding leadership and actually leading are two different activities." Your Church, ministry, committee, or small-group rises and falls on your leadership. But just understanding leadership isn't enough. Leading is about relationships, and relationships rise and fall on communication.

Last month *in this column* we discussed how managing communication is critical to the success of any organization, especially the Church. Church communication management is about sharing information in a proactive way to keep members informed and engaged.

This is a right now word for both Pastors and ministry leaders: keep your leaders/leadership team in the loop. If your Church has a viable Christian nurture option, like Sunday School, systematic Bible study opportunities, etc., the Ministry Associate for Christian Nurture or whoever is responsible for Christian Education should meet at least once each month with the faculty, those who teach. Also, Pastor, never assume that your Leadership Team know what you're thinking or where things are headed. Things that are obvious to you won't be to them. Leaders perform better when they're informed.

I subscribe to the idea that "Church leadership meetings should happen as often as needed, but never more often than necessary." So, I might meet with my Executive Leadership Team and the Joint Body (trustees and diaconate) at least twice each month, sometimes separately and, at other times, together. How does your Church do Leadership Meetings?

The point is, effectively and proficiently connecting the right message to the right people at the right time is the consummate goal of communication. In even a moderately active Church culture, this can only be done with a good communication strategy. Your Church communication plan should be engaging, informative and inspiring.

Church Leaders should be informed, conferences across the country.



but so should the **Church Membership**. Keep your Church Family informed. These people love you, and they love the church. They deserve clear and concise communication.

recommend practicing the power of seven in communicating with your Church membership. You may already be familiar with The Rule of Seven in terms of marketing, which posits that a message will need to be communicated seven times before it is "bought" by a consumer. For pastors and Church leaders, this means that if you want to communicate well, you should try to repeat your message through several (preferably seven) different avenues. For example, if you are preaching on the stewardship of giving, then you should restate that message in some form in your weekly email, text messages, Facebook post, Sunday worship guide, Church website, robo-call, and Church billboard. Cover your bases to communicate to the "plugged in" and the "unplugged" by both print and digital forms of media. The more times a person sees or hears a message, the more likely it is to "stick."

Last, but not least, have a communication plan for your **external communications**. Your Church says something to the outside whether you like it or not. You can control what it says and how loud it is by developing and implementing a strategic communication plan.

Blessings on your ministry to the glory of God. We'll talk again next month.

"Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Life Undeniably Persevering in Prayer" Part 1

Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (James 1:4)

Undeniably persevering con-

veys the message that I am going through something rather difficult in my life with little to no indication of success but despite it all, I must continue to press forward. In order for you to reach a level of maturity in perseverance, you have to be tested. The Father will never test any child without having a knowledge of what they are capable of handling. Every test orchestrated by the Father carries an escape route and a nutritional pack of endurance. (1 Cor. 10:13) It is the Father's will that you choose the route He has set out before you. The plans that He has for you are not for your disaster but for your success and a good future. (Jer. 29:11) As you yield to the Father's designed path, patience and endurance will be the fuel to carry you through to the finish line and declare, "I am UP-Undeniably Persevering!"

You will never know the strength of your faith until the level of your endurance is exposed. This means that you must be tested in order for your faith to mature. Your faith cannot grow unless it is proven. Faith is total reliance

in God. When pressure shows up, it comes to present the question before you, "who will you trust to see you through?" Jesus demonstrated to us the importance of perseverance through the foundation of prayer. Just think for a moment. Every struggle He endured occurred in prayer. The wilderness was a place of isolation, testing, and strengthening. The Garden of Gethsemane was a place of struggle, betrayal, and surrender. The cross was a place of suffering, intercession, and forgiveness.

Throughout His ministry, Jesus separated Himself from the demands of ministry to a solitary place to pray and get in the presence of the Father for instruction and strength. His life depicted clearly that ministry comes with a price. As He ministered, He was loved and hated. He was ostracized and highly criticized. He was falsely accused, lied upon, wounded, and beaten. He was misunderstood and misquoted. Yet, despite it all, He never got out of character. Even when He got angry, He maintained integrity. This is the byproduct of an authentic lifestyle of prayer. This is the level I want to encourage you to ignite in your heart as a child of God. Despite what you are facing, there lies within you the ability to be able to persevere in prayer and prevail by the grace of God.

Jesus gave us a clear directive to "pray and never give up." (Luke



18:1) He was reminding us of the importance of not just living a lifestyle of prayer but also developing a prayer language. This means that every prayer lifted up before the Father must be measured by His Word. Praying in spirit and truth is praying God's will, which is His Word. Meditating on God's Word develops your prayer language, which influences your life. (Josh. 1:8) When you pray, God is not focusing on your list of needs, He is listening for what His Word says about your needs! (Read Matthew 6) Whew, glory!

To get to the place in which you undeniably persevere in prayer, you must establish your own personal prayer closet, which we will discuss in next month's column. Until then, be determined to establish and maintain a lifestyle of prayer that will provoke you to not quit but undeniably persevere.

LIVING HISTORY, **HONORED LEGACY**

"If money doesn't grow on trees, then where does it come from?

Mr. Shallie Monroe Bey

Honoring and Saluting the Legacy of New Mount Rose' Mr. Shallie Monroe Bey, Jr., the Youngest and First and Only African-American Superintendent US Mint ever from 1976-1980 in Observation of the 400-year Anniversary of the first Arrival of Africans in America in 1619 to 2019. By Pastor Kyev Tatum, Sr., New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church

FORT WORTH, TEXAS - Shallie Monroe Bey, Jr. is the youngest person ever appointed to the prestigious position of Superintendent, Department of the Treasury, United States Mint, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Responsible for the operation of the largest mint in the U. S., Bey has also served as the industrial representative to the Office of Minority Affairs and the Department of State.

Nominated by President Jimmy Carter and confirmed by the United States Senate, Mr. Bey became the First African-American to hold this position in

On April 2, 1792, Congress passed the Coinage Act, establishing the first national mint in the United States, Congress chose Philadelphia, what was then the nation's capital, as the site of our first Mint. As gold fever spread across the U.S., branch Mints and assay offices opened to serve the needs of a growing nation. Although the Mint currently operates branch Mints in Philadelphia, San Francisco, Denver, and West Point, and a bullion depository at Fort Knox, many other facilities opened throughout our history. Use the resources below to learn more about Mint's 225 years and counting as one of the federal government's oldest agencies.

Bey was born March 26, 1949, in Gary, Ind. He received a B.S.E.E. from Purdue University in 1971 and an M.B.A. from the University of Pennsylvania in

From 1971 to 1973, Bey was an engineer with the Sun Oil Co. in Toledo, Ohio. From 1973 to 1977, he was with the Alliance Enterprise Corp. in Philadelphia, a venture capital investment company and Sun Co. subsidiary, where he served as vice president and director in 1973 and 1974 and president and director from 1974 to 1977.

Since 1977 Bey has been planning coordinator for the Sun Co. in Radnor, Pa., where he is responsible for coordinating the planning and operations for six operating subsidiaries.

Bey served as a resident engineer for the Minority Introduction to Engineering Program at Purdue and was named a Distinguished Engineering Alumnus in





The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word... Rev. J.R. Brumfield

"Stepping Out on Faith"

Matthew 14:22-33

1. Introduction

When one chooses to attempt great accomplishments, then one must consider the aspects of stepping out of one's comfort zone. In early biblical history, we find that Abraham was called to step out on faith. In Genesis 12:1-3, we see that the Lord God had a call upon Abraham's life to leave his family and kindred and go to a place that the Lord would show him. Considering that Abraham's family resided in the land of Ur. we see extraordinary faith exemplified by this patriarch. This was a thriving city on the banks of the Mesopotamia. Most people have an attachment to their home and it is not easy to leave familiar places. If the Lord had called you to leave your homeland, would you be able to obey God like Abraham? From the biblical account of Abraham's life, we find that he was rewarded with a promise of the promise land. Abraham received repeated promises and a covenant that his "seed" would inherit the land. When we choose to step out on faith, we will be greatly rewarded. Abraham is known as the Father of the faithful.

As we study the Apostle Paul's life, we find that he had endured threats on his life and numerous beatings. He was imprisoned, stoned, and suffered many hardships for the cause of Christ. (2 Cor. 11:23-28). Yet, these troubles and trials did not hinder the Apostle Paul from a desire to do God's will. The Scriptures do not inform us that the Apostle Paul took a vacation to rest from his encounters with trouble. One might say that he stepped out on faith and obeyed God in the midst of his troubles. He wanted to do more for the Lord God. The Apostle Paul informs the Roman Christians that he wants to see them, but he won't be staving long. He wants to go to Spain to preach the gospel. Paul's heart desire was to preach Christ in places that had not received the gospel of Jesus Christ. As we survey the canvas of Paul's final years, he was still dreaming big for God. He wanted to preach the gospel to people that did not have a relationship with the Lord God. Do you dream big for the Lord God?

There have been many examples where people have realized their dreams because they had a faith that refused to quit. When we consider the life of the three Hebrew boys, we see that they went into the fiery furnace with a faith that God is able to deliver them out of the fire. Do you believe that the Lord can deliver you from the challenges of this life and allow you to reach your destiny? As we approach the text, we will find that Peter had a desire to dream big and walk on water. We should expect great things from the Lord God, and attempt great things for the Lord God.

2. Contrary Winds, v.22-26

Just to know that we have the Lord with us, we are assured of the victory. In this text, we find that Jesus commands his



disciples to go to the other side. We do not find anywhere in this passage where they obeyed His word. These disciples do not respond similar to Jonah in the Old Testament. They did not run from their assignment. It is important to note that when we encounter hard trials along our assigned journey, help is available. In Psalms 46:1, we are enlightened that God is a very present help in the time of trouble. These disciples obeyed the Lord and set sail to go to the other side. As we journey through this life, we will encounter storms along the way. It appears that the weather was nice when the disciples set sail for the other side. However, as they went further along their journey, they saw that the clouds began to gather all around them

This passage informs the believer that Jesus went up into a mountain to pray while the disciples set sail to the other side. It is good to know that we have a Savior that acts on our behalf as our go-between us and the Lord. While Jesus is in the place of prayer, the disciples are down on the Sea of Galilee. The storm develops while the disciples are on the water. They are in the place of peril. It should be a relief to every child of God that the Lord knows our every position, peril, and He has the power to deliver us. The Lord Jesus sees his disciples struggling with the storm. The disciples are toiling and rowing but Jesus comes toward the boat. When we are struggling and straining with life's difficulties, our Lord can come and see about us. We do not have to worry if the Lord can handle our situations. He is well able to handle any situation that we are confronted with in life.

The Word instructs the believer that the Lord Jesus comes to his disciples in the fourth watch. When they see Him, they say, "It is a spirit, and they cried out with fear." Somebody might feel that the disciples should not have felt this way but how would you have reacted in this situ-

3. Calming Words, v. 27-31

Although the disciples began to have some fear and doubts, the Lord Jesus tells them to be of good cheer. The Lord Jesus tells them, "It is I." As long as the Lord Jesus is on board our ships, then we have that calm assurance. There are teachable moments in this passage because the disciples are being trained to walk by faith. They must believe as they go along their journey in life that the Lord

is with them when they can't see Him. We must remember the Lord's promise that He will never leave us or forsake us. In Romans 8, we are reminded that nothing can separate us from the love of God. He that keeps Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. We serve a God that is available to our every need in this life.

If Christ's disciples are not cheerful in a storm, then it is their fault. The Lord Jesus tells his disciples to be of good cheer. We must be courageous when we encounter struggles in life. Nothing should be a terror to the believer when we have the Lord standing by to help us.

In verse 8, Peter makes a request to the disciples reacted with reluctance but come closer to the Lord and walk on water. When Christ is coming towards us in a way of mercy, we must go forth to meet him in a way of duty. Peter expected big things from God because if he received the permission to come toward the Lord then the Lord Jesus would allow him to walk on water. We must be willing and bold to venture with him and venture for him. If any person wants to have the benefits of Christ, then one must come by faith to the Lord Jesus Christ. Peter walks on water but when he took his eves off the Lord then he began to sink. We cannot allow the boisterous winds to take our eves off the Lord Jesus. In verse 31, we are informed that Jesus stretched forth his hand and caught Peter. Our Lord can catch us before it is too late. As long as we keep our eyes on the prize, we will be alright!

4. Cause for Worship, v. 32-33

The reason why the Lord performed this miracle on the water for His disciples is that their faith might be strengthened. When we think about how the Lord has made a way for us, our faith should be strengthened. When Christ comes into a soul, He makes winds and storms to cease there, and commands peace, This passage tells us that the winds and the waves ceased and there was a great calm. In verse 33, the Word tells us that when Jesus and Peter came into the ship. they began to worship Him. These things were done that the disciples might worship Him and know that He was the Son of God. When we think about the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living, we should worship the Lord.

As we face an uncertain tomorrow, let's remember that what the Lord has done for others, he can do for you. Please remember that you can step out on faith as the disciples set sail for the other side. You can make it to the other side safely with Jesus on board!
