"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

The term **leadership** is defined as "the art of motivating a group of people to act towards achieving a common goal." Of course, there are other definitions of "leadership," but this as on point as you can get. Leadership is a gift. It's among the spiritual gifts listed in Scripture: "If God has given you leadership ability, take the responsibility seriously" (Romans 12:8).

Leadership is about mapping out where you need to go to "win" as a team or a Congregation. Now, I'm sure you've discovered that being in a leadership position doesn't make a person a leader. In fact, someone can be in a leadership position and not have any leadership abilities. A positional leader has some position of authority but is not practicing any form of leadership. Donald H. Mc-Gannon (September 9, 1920 – May 23, 1984), once Chairman of Westinghouse Broadcasting Company, is quoted as saying, "Leadership is action, not position."

Positional leaders, whether clergy or laity, have contributed to the demise of countless ministries, committees, and Churches. Internationally respected leadership guru and pastor John Maxwell, writing in his book *The 5 Levels Of Leadership*, categorizes positional leadership as "the lowest level of leadership." He continues, "Position is the only level that does not require ability and effort to achieve. Anyone can be appointed to a position."

Frankly, it's a real challenge in most Churches to get someone to volunteer to lead a ministry, small group, or committee, so the pastor or whoever is responsible for recruiting the Church leadership team will settle for a "warm body" to fill some leadership vacancy. Needless to say, this is a recipe for disaster. As a pastor, I would rather leave a leadership seat vacant than fill it with someone who isn't qualified and doesn't have the disposition or the demeanor necessary to lead effectively.

But, what happens when the positional leader is the pastor? Doug

He conducts leadership seminar conferences across the country.



Franklin, president of LeaderTreks, says, "Many of us think we are incharge because we have a title that says we are but we are not really leading." There are pastors who are gifted preachers and insightful teachers, but are dysfunctional leaders. Leading successfully is impossible without vision because you have to be leading somewhere. And, I've known pastors who wear the position but are severely challenged when it comes to actually shepherdizing the flock. By default, those who fail to lead their congregations are often content to be chaplains who feverishly run from need to need without leading the flock in a particular direc-

Not long ago a newly-minted pastor asked me, "Doc, now that I'm a pastor...what's next? I'm wedded to prayer. My marriage is healthy. My children are doing nicely. I love the folk. What else can I do?" After encouraging him in what he is doing well, I replied, "Perform competently." To perform competently means you know what you are doing in your job. To be a leader means you have to be able to do your job capably and be able to teach others to do it. Mistakes will always happen. But what separates great leaders from average leaders is what comes after the mistake: acknowledge it, learn from it, and try as best as you can to never do it again. Perform competently. You have the job, now do it!

"Speak Life Thought" with First Lady & Co-Pastor Yolanda G. Butler

"A Life Undeniably Persevering in Prayer" Part 3

Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (James 1:4)

The past two months, I encouraged you to develop a mindset of undeniably persevering in prayer despite the difficulty life brings with little to no indication of success. I challenged you to establish your personal prayer closet, a place free from interruption and distraction to build intimacy with the Father.

For the next thirty days, I want to encourage you to practice the following five steps to help develop a lifestyle of persevering in prayer in your prayer closet.

- 1. Don't Quit! Make up in your mind that quitting is not an option. No matter how hard it is, you have to retreat to prayer to fight every battle. "Pray and never give up." (Luke 18:1) "Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might." (Eph 6:10)
- **2. Set your atmosphere.** Establish your atmosphere

through songs of worship. "But now bring me a minstrel. And it came to pass, when the minstrel played, that the hand of the Lord came upon him." (2 Kings 3:15) "Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ." (Eph. 5:19-20)

- 3. Seek one word. Every waking day, ask the Holy Spirit to give you one word that will establish your day. "The centurion answered and said, "Lord, I am not worthy that You should come under my roof. But only speak a word, and my servant will be healed." (Matt. 8:8 CEV)
- 4. Meditate. Search the Word of God for scriptures that line up with the one word the Holy Spirit established in your heart to carry you through your day. "And don't for a minute let this Book of The Revelation be out of mind. Ponder and meditate on it day and night, making sure you practice everything written in it. Then you'll get where you're going; then you'll succeed." (Joshua 1:8 Msg)
- 5. Pray and give thanks. Pray



and thank God for giving you the victory as you go about your day. "So let us come boldly to the throne of our gracious God. There we will receive his mercy, and we will find grace to help us when we need it most." (Heb. 4:16 NLT) "Pray without ceasing. In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." (1 Thess. 5:17-18 KJV)

As you establish the foundation of prayer in your life, no matter what comes up against you, there lies within you a strength that will not allow you to quit. Until then, be determined to rise and undeniably persevere in prayer and you shall prevail.

FLATLINE FORT WORTH - PROVERBS 17:17 A New Project To Address the Worse Parity and Life Expectancy of African-American Males in the State of Texas and Beyond on Saturday, May 25, 2019 at 10am at New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church 2864 Mississippi Avenue Fort Worth, Texas 76104. In Honor and In Memory of the Life and Legacy of Mr.

Aubrey Thagard

FORT WORTH, TEXAS - In Fort Worth, the life expectancy in one of the city's poorest ZIP codes is as low as it is in a third world country. In fact, the 76104 ZIP code has the lowest life expectancy rate in the State of Texas at 67 years, with black males having the lowest life expectancy rate of any group at 64 years.

The UT Southwestern researcher behind a new study, Dr. Sandi Pruitt calls it shocking. She's teamed up with a local pastor Kyev Tatum to do something about it.

They started with a call to action summit on April 13th. Now local pastors and community leaders are inviting the City leaders back together on May 25th to identify and address the root causes impacting parity and life expectancy of black men in Fort Worth.

"Our African-American men are dying and no one seems to care," says, Pastor Kyev Tatum of the New Mount Rose Missionary Baptist Church and President of CityEquity, USA, Inc., a non-profit dedicated to improving the parity and life expectancy of people living in inner-city communities across the country.

The urgency of this project was made crystal clear one week after the health summit was held.

According to the City of Fort Worth's website, Neighborhood Services Director, Aubrey Thagard passed away at 9:38 a.m. April 20 at Texas Health Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth. He is survived by his wife, Danielle, who was at his bedside when he died. "We ask that the Fort Worth community please keep Danielle and Aubrey's family in their thoughts and prayers during this difficult time," said a statement from the Fort Worth City Manager's Office.

Aubrey and his team was very instrumental in organizing the call to action summit.

Now organizers will honor his life and legacy by establishing Flatline Fort Worth to begin addressing the underline causes of disparities and inequality for African-American males in 76104.

"Now is the time to seize the moment and change the trajectory of life expectancy in our innercity black community as we seek to make Fort Worth a better place for everyone, especially for those of us who have shown no record of success, educationally, economically, emotionally and environmentally over the last 40 years. Our history requires it, our times demand it, our children deserve it and God is Still Watching," says Pastor Kyev Tatum.



The Gospel Corner with Proclaimer of the Word...

A Mother's Endurance Genesis 16:3-10:

I. INTRODUCTION

As people across the land celebrate mother's day, we must delve deeper into the reality of motherhood. There have been many mothers that have suffered the pains of childbirth and the pains of raising children. A good mother will be with their children when others have pushed the child aside. Sometimes fathers will walk away from their children but the good mother will stand by her children even when everyone else has left the child's side. There are many mothers that are forced to raise their children in poverty and see their children suffer from lack of basic necessities. It is my prayer that these mothers will find comfort one day.

When I think about the mothers that are travelling on the caravan from Mexico to the United States, my prayers go out for them. One would think that all hearts are saddened due to the struggles that these mothers face. Yet, our history is filled with examples of mothers who have had to endure the hardships of life. For instance, during slavery, mothers had to watch their children being sold on the auction block of a cruel government system. Families were sometimes torn apart due to the prevailing winds of injustice in this country. Yet the black community has stood as a light upon a hill working together to look after each other.

One of the most endearing movies I have seen is the movie entitled "Imitation of Life." In this movie, there was a young daughter that did not want to be associated with her good mother. One might say the daughter forgot about the things that were important in this life. Every time the mother would reach out to her daughter, the daughter would run away. Can you imagine how this mother may have felt when her only daughter would act like she did not know her mother at times? Can you see the gripping reality that some children push their mothers away? It is always a tragedy when children do not properly honor their parents. The bible is explicit in the way we should treat our mothers or any elderly woman. When the mother died in the movie, "Imitation of Life", one would have thought this young daughter may have regretted the times she pushed her mother away. We should cherish the time we have with our mother. It is too late to show love to our mothers when they are resting in the arms of the Lord. Let's do all we can to help our mothers during their lifetime.

Sometimes mothers have to deal with sickness in their bodies but they still love their children. Sometimes mothers have to deal with children that do not show love and respect. However, I want to remind every person that has a living mother, do all you can while she is alive. Let's see what happens in the life of Hagar who had to endure the hardships in a family. Hagar was a mother that loved her son Ishmael but she faced adversity.

II. CAST AWAY, v.3-6

As men and women of God, we must be careful that we make wise choices regarding our families. As we delve into this text, we find that Sarah is the instigator of this great sin and her husband Abraham adhered to her bad advice. When we don't obey God then



sin and trouble lie at our doors. We should consider that we are the cause for our guilt and grief when we don't do what is right. Sarah encouraged her husband to have sexual relations with her servant Hagar. After this marriage occurred, and the baby was born, Hagar exhibited a spirit of disrespect toward Sarah. When we look at Genesis 21:9-13, we find that Sarah told her husband that Hagar needed to leave immediately. Hagar forgot her place in the family because she became lifted up with pride.

As a result of a bad decision by both Abraham and Sarah, Hagar was in a bad position. To add misery to misery, Hagar did not behave herself wisely once her child was conceived. Hagar should have remained humble in the eyesight of her master but she became filled with pride and this eventually hurt her position in the family. When we allow a haughty spirit to engulf our lives, we are in danger of pride. Due to bad decision and a prideful spirit exhibited by Hagar, the family is in jeopardy. Sarah placed the blame for her bad decision upon her husband Abraham. Sarah told her husband. "may the Lord judge between you and me." It is absurd when people do not take ownership of the wrong that they have done in the relationship. Since Sarah was Abraham's wife, then Abraham left the matter in Sarah's hand regarding the punishment of Hagar. This was a wise move for Abraham to leave the fate of Hagar in his wife Sarah's hands. Sarah chose to greatly afflict Hagar and cast her away from the home. The Lord God is not pleased when we elect to place hardships upon our servants or those whom we have the responsibility to lead. In this passage, we find that Hagar could not endure Sarah's harsh treatment and she left the camp headed for the wilderness. As believers in the body of Christ, we have to be careful that we do not cause our weaker sisters and brothers to stumble along the way. Hagar is now on the run and she is headed in the wrong direction. Hagar is headed toward Egypt. As students of the Word, we know that Egypt represents a place of sin. Hagar is headed in the wrong direction and she is going away from her blessing. Have you caused anyone to stray away from the church? Have anyone ever caused you to stray away from the faith? Have you ever been a cast away? Hagar is now a cast away and headed in the wrong direction.

III. CALL TO ALLEGIANCE, v.7-9

It is here in this passage that we have the appearance of an angel. Since Hagar was an Egyptian, she was headed back home. I am sure that Hagar felt that she did not have to settle for Sarah's insults. Hagar was headed back to Shur. We see that Hagar was now out of the way of her duty. When the angel approached Hagar, he found her going further astray. It is a great mercy to be stopped

in a sinful way either by conscience or by Providence. Hagar was not stopped by the angel until she was in the wilderness. Sin can place us in a wilderness outside of the will of the Lord God for our lives.

In verse 8, the angel calls her by her name. He called her Hagar, Sarah's maid. This was a check to Hagar's pride. The angel does not call her Hagar, Abraham's wife but Sarah's maid. Oh how humbling it may have been to Hagar to go back and serve Sarah! One would think that since Hagar was abused by Sarah, this journey back to her master would seem absurd. The Lord God knows how to work on the heart of Sarah and He can work on the heart of Hagar.

As a rebuke to Hagar travelling in the wilderness back to Egypt, the angel arrest Hagar and tells her to go back to Sarah. When we go out of the path of duty, our Lord God knows how to bring us back to our senses. As bible scholars, we know that the Lord can arrest anyone that goes outside of His will. If we could speak to Jonah, he would tell us that the Lord God can arrest you in the belly of a whale. When Jonah came out of the whale, he was ready to serve his Master.

The angel confronts Hagar with a question. "Where are you going?" Hagar had an honest answer and she said, "I flee from the face of my mistress." As leaders in society, we must treat those under our watch with tender care lest we provoke them to go outside of God's will. In verse 9, the angel directs Hagar to go back home to Sarah and serve her. The angel tells Hagar to go home and humble herself for what she has done amiss. The angel tells Sarah that she must ask for a pardon for her wrong and pledge allegiance that she will do better. Have you ever had to go back and tell someone that you were wrong? When we sin and go astray, our Lord has made provisions for us to get back right with Him. We can pray and turn from our evil ways and the Lord will heal our land

IV. CALM ASSURANCE, v.10

After Hagar decides to go back home to Sarah, then the angel gives her a calm assurance that all will be well with her household. The angel tells Hagar that the Lord God has mercy in store for her and her seed. The Lord God decided to bless Hagar's descendents exceedingly because she believed God. God will meet those with mercy who are returning to their duty. As Christians, we must stay in the path of duty no matter the difficulties in our way! Our Lord God knows our trouble and He is standing by to help us in the time of trouble! I submit to you that Hagar had to endure hardships but she was blessed for her obedience to God's will. Have you obeved the voice of the Lord? Are you living within God's will for your life?






