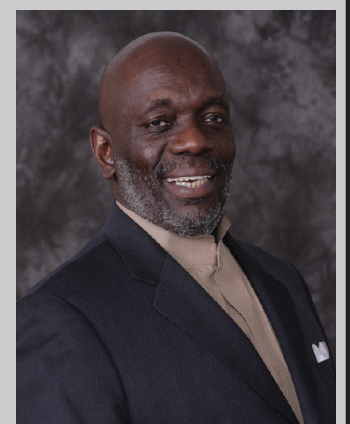

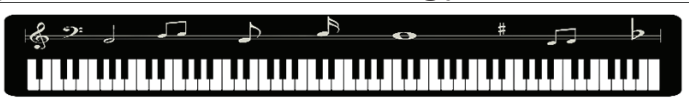

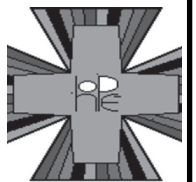

"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

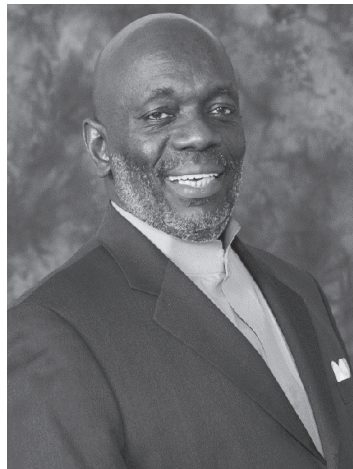
November is planning month for some local congregations. 2025 is no longer around the corner; it's just up the street. Where is God leading us in the New Year? What are the next steps for the ministry I've been tagged to lead?

Saddleback Church Founder and executive director of the Finishing the Task mission coalition Rick Warren writes, in a Pastors.com article, that "Good leaders are planners. They always think through where they're headed, and they don't waste time worrying about failure. Effective ministry leaders start with prayer, and then they plan what God wants them to accomplish." It true. Almost every task that's done well is done twice. It's done, first, mentally in the minds of those who have leadership roles. This process of thinking through what is to be done is what we call planning.

In the dynamic landscape of church leadership, the significance of planning shouldn't be downplayed or overemphasized. Effective planning serves as the backbone of a thriving ministry, allowing leaders to navigate challenges, allocate resources wisely, and fulfill their mission with clarity and purpose. Unfortunately, too few churches have a *great planning process*. Truth be told, even in the 21st century, most congregations don't even have a good *planning process*, if they have a process at all.

I'm not sure why this isn't a bigger priority. Planning is certainly biblical. From the very beginning, the Sacred Canon highlights the significance of planning. In Genesis, God meticulously orchestrated creation, establishing order amidst chaos. This blueprint sets a precedent for church leaders. To be effective stewards of their ministries, your church leadership team must approach their work with intentionality and foresight. Planning is not merely a logistical necessity; it is an act of faith, reflecting the understanding that God operates within a framework of time and purpose.

At the heart of effective planning is a clear vision, which is indispensable for any ministry. Proverbs 29:18 reminds us, "Where there is no vision, the people perish." Biblical vision is seeing what God wants you to see.



Our God is a God of order and not chaos, so our ministries should have a clear plan of where they're going and how God is going to take them there.

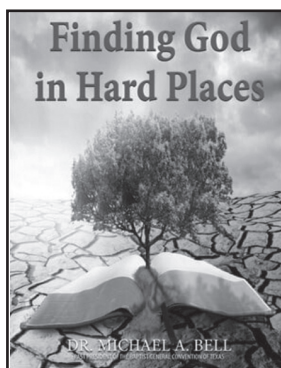
As you look ahead to God's future for your church and/or arena of ministry, what are some of the particulars of wise planning?

You should **start with a good understanding of where you are now**. Make an assessment. Where is your "Here" and what resources needed for you to reach your "There?"

Second, **clarify and focus your vision**; define where you're going and how you're going to get there. Promote alignment by involving ministry leaders from all of your departments to get on the same page about what you're trying to accomplish. Ask and answer the question, "Are the right people in the right roles?" This will help prevent ministry silos and conflicting agendas.

Then, periodically evaluate how you're doing and what, if anything, needs to be tweaked or changed. Your planning process needs to incorporate timelines, deadlines and appraisal. It needs to be a living, breathing thing that gets refreshed regularly as God leads your church into the future.

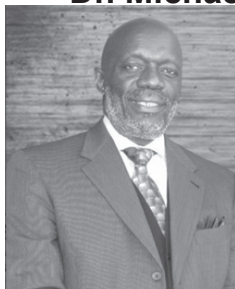

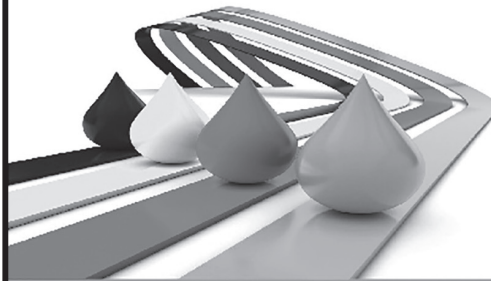

A Life of Thankfulness

"By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another. (John 13:35)"

Here we are once again upon the close of another year. November houses one of my favorite holidays and that is Thanksgiving. For the next thirty days, would you join me in a challenge to extend thankfulness by doing one thankful deed each day? Jesus said that people will know true love by the way we demonstrate it. So, I have set out 30 ways that you can implement to demonstrate a life of thankfulness towards God, yourself, and others. As always, each day should be approached with prayer for Holy Spirit's leading. Create a gratitude journal and write down each action accomplished for the next 30 days.

1. **Text** someone and tell them how thankful you are for them.
2. **Call** someone and tell them how thankful you are for them.
3. **Send** someone a card and let them know how thankful you are for them.
4. **Tip** your server more than normal.
5. **Do** a random act of kindness.
6. **Write** a letter of thankfulness to the Father.

8. **Give** a small gift that expresses thankfulness
9. **Hug** someone
10. **Post** a thankful note on social media
11. **Thank** the cashier.
12. **Visit** someone sick or shut-in
13. **Volunteer** at a local charity or outreach program
14. **Celebrate** a milestone in someone's life.
15. **Step aside** and allow someone else to go ahead of you in line.
16. **Share** your skills and talents freely.
17. **Support** someone who is going through a tough time.
18. **Pay it forward.** Pay someone else's bill behind you in line.
19. **Be positive and thankful ALL day.** No complaining, murmuring, shouting at the drivers, talking under your breath, yelling, growling, etc.
20. **Help** someone who is overwhelmed.
21. **Meditate, reflect, and appreciate** the small things in life in a BIG way.
22. **Declutter** your closet and donate to a local charity.
23. **Be present,** actively listen, connect, and engage.
24. **Show up ON TIME** for that appointment, that service, engagement, etc.
25. **Slow down** and exhibit patience even if you are in a hurry.



26. **Make time** for yourself. Treat yourself to a massage, pedicure, day of rest, etc.
27. **Touch and agree** with someone in prayer.
28. **Express** gratitude to your leaders (spiritual and in the workforce).
29. **Smile and be kind** to someone even if they are rude and ugly.
30. **Keep** your promise.

DOE'S YOUR CHURCH NEED STREAMING LICENSE? Which Streaming License is Right for your Church?

Christian Copyright Solutions

You have options when deciding which streaming license your church needs. Christian Copyright Solutions (CCS) and Christian Copyright Licensing International (CCLI) both offer church streaming licenses that provide coverage for your church-owned website (churchname.com). Not sure which one is right for your church or ministry? The answers to a few key questions may help guide your licensing choice.

1. What type of performances, services, or events will you be streaming?
2. What types of songs or music will you play during the streaming session?
3. Does your church use sound recordings during your streaming service?

Performances Covered

The WORSHIPcast Streaming License covers live and archived performances of your worship services, allowing your congregation to worship whenever and wherever; it does not cover podcasting. The CCLI Streaming License allows podcasting and streaming of worship services only. So, if you plan on streaming just your worship services, the CCLI Streaming License has you covered. However, for the flexibility to engage your congregation by streaming worship services, special events, and guest performances, your church will need the WORSHIPcast License.

Songs Covered

The WORSHIPcast Streaming License covers more

than 28 million secular and Christian songs across all genres, including children's, holiday, and patriotic music from the catalogs of ASCAP, BMI, and SES-AC. The CCLI Streaming License covers more than 300,000 Christian songs from the CCLI catalog. If you're planning on only streaming Christian music, and your church maintains a CCL Copyright License, the CCLI Streaming License is a great fit. If your church or ministry plans to stream any music outside the CCLI catalog, you will need a WORSHIPcast License.

Sound Recordings or Multitracks

Many churches enhance their streaming service with master recordings, backing tracks, multitracks, or stems. If this is your church, CCLI's Streaming Plus can provide you with over 150,000 recordings that can be used anytime throughout your service stream. The WORSHIPcast Streaming License can not provide coverage for sound recordings. Licensing is available from the master recording owner.

Other Considerations

The CCLI Streaming License provides coverage to show lyrics for the songs in the CCLI catalog and to stream on social media or other third-party platforms. Unfortunately, no blanket lyric reproduction streaming license for secular music is currently available.

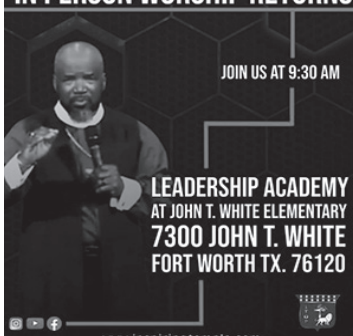

Everything you need to know to safely dispose of used batteries | CITY NEWS

Although batteries are essential for a variety of household items, they can also be dangerous once they have reached the end of their life.

Why it matters: Used batteries that are not properly discarded can lead to human and environmental health hazards. Batteries can damage the ecosystem by leaking harmful chemicals into soil and waterways. They can also start fires in collection trucks, at recycling and garbage processing plants, and even in collection carts.

Ways to prevent battery disposal hazards:

Do not put batteries in the blue recycling cart or brown garbage cart. Drop off batteries at any of the City's four drop-off stations or the Environmental Collection Center (ECC).

Return used batteries to retailers



that accept battery returns for recycling.

After disposal: Once residents have dropped off their used batteries to a drop-off station or the ECC, batteries are separated by size and are safely placed inside storage drums. The batteries are then taken to a battery recycling facility.

God loves us. And he is so deeply concerned about what we need, not what we want.

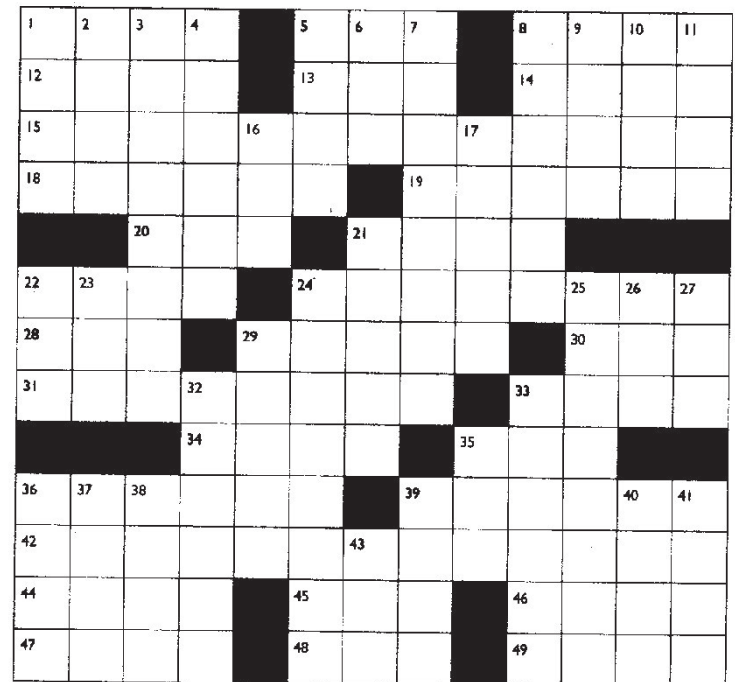

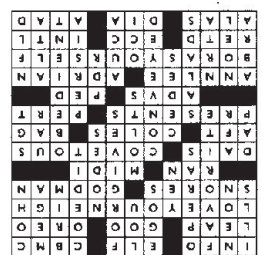
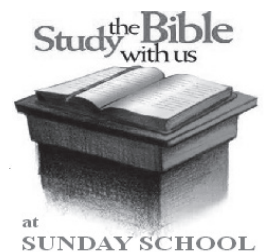
