

"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Covid 19 has been an undeniable game-changer for all of us. The coronavirus has placed unprecedented demands on leaders in every facet of life. The massive scale of the virus outbreak ushered in change on an enormous scale, particularly in the church. To say that the Covid crisis is a hinge point for the church is not an exaggeration. The church's mission remains the same. But the execution of that mission has looked different during the pandemic and will likely continue to be different even after the pandemic has run its course.

Across this country, pastors and church ministry leaders are assessing what's left. What kind of toll did the pandemic have on your church attendance and membership participation? The Barna Group, a research firm with a particular focus on the Christian church in the U.S., estimates that in-person attendance is roughly 30%-50% lower than it was before the pandemic. There used to be seven choirs but now there's only leadership for three choirs. I recently talked with a pastor friend who preached three worship services every Sunday pre-pandemic. But since reopening its doors, the church he leads has one worship service each

Decreased attendance, diminished participation and inadequate financial resources for mission and ministry seem to be the order of the day for most churches going forward. While some congregations might experience an across-the-board rebound as the pandemic recedes, many don't expect attendance to return to pre-Covid levels. That has left churches looking for different approaches to connect with existing members and attract new ones.

Like Nehemiah prayerfully inspecting the city walls before calling people to rise up and build, church leaders need to be conscious of their surroundings, paying special attention to how things are changing and move *full-speed-ahead* to conceptualize workable strategies that effectuate church growth.

One thing we have to acknowledge if we're going to effectively do mission and ministry, is that there's a new front door. Your church service used to be the front door, the

way most people experienced your church for the first time. Over the past three years, we've realized that folk visited our website before they ever stepped one foot on our church campus. So, we got busy and shifted the point of our website to be focused on new people and added "plan a visit" language. But things have shifted again. Now, people first experience your church by what they see and hear on social media, Facebook, YouTube, twitter, etc.

So, how do you respond to this latest shift? Start by sharing helpful content online and use it to build trust over time. Highlight things that matter to people in your community (not just things that are important to you). Build an audience (and an email list) of people who want personal and practical guidance

The average social media user spends more than an hour every day on social media. So you can see immediately the importance of having an effective church social media strategy. Social media has the potential to help your church share the message of Jesus with hundreds or even thousands of people. Like it or not, churchgoers and non-churchgoers alike are being discipled from the pulpit of their social media feeds. This is a reality churches need to acknowledge. And it could be an opportunity, depending on what we make of it.





"A Fall Back Life"

"Then it happened, when he made mention of the ark of God, that Eli fell off the seat backward by the side of the gate; and his neck was broken and he died, for the man was old and heavy" (1 Sam 4:18)

According to the Orlando Sentinel, "When the U.S. entered World War I in 1918, Congress passed the Uniform Time Act – making the railroad times official across the nation and calling for daylight saying time every year from March to October — to save electricity and make the nation more productive by keeping the sun out later." Today, every first Sunday of November our nation 'falls back" to its regular daylight time schedule as our days become shorter and nights become longer due to the shift in the earth's axis. Productivity tends to dimmish in the daylight, but heavier crime activity rises in the evening. This simple scientific/economic lesson reminds us that there are times in which we are going to have to fall back but must be careful not to fall out into sin. Keep the Son shining in your life.

Eli served as Israel's priest responsible for the spiritual and judicial health of the nation. Unfortunately, as he began to decline in age, he fell back away from God's Holy Standards concerning his sacred office. He failed to discipline his sons (Hophni and Phineas) early in their service for their wicked actions as priests. Outwardly, they acted the part, but inwardly they did not know and serve the Holy God. Rather, than fall forward into forgiveness, they chose to fall back and remain in sin. They were ultimately judged by the Father with

Next, we see that at some point in Eli's life he became "heavy." The Hebrew word for "heavy" is defined as being severe and difficult. Eli allowed his physical health to decline, and he fell backwards into severe obesity. As a result, he developed some health issues which affected, among other things, his natural sight. Spiritual obesity not only affects you naturally but also spiritually. You become weighed down with the cares of the world making it difficult to maneuver in faith. This chokes out the Word in your life and makes you unfruitful (Mark 4:19). Eli was not able to serve effectively as priest and judge, or even tend to his own household. His neglect and decline led to his tragic death.

The unfortunate reality is that the pandemic years have caused many to fall back to a lifestyle of sin and folly. Opting for online service



rather than in-person has caused many to become lazy. Proverbs 26:11 gives a harsh disgusting reality that, "Like a dog that returns to his vomit is a fool who repeats his folly." It is a dangerous state to be in and the Bible is clear that if you stay in a fallen back condition, the penalty is death (Rom. 6:23).

Dear hearts, if we are to fall back, let it be on the Word of God. Retreat to the Father who has promised to order your steps (Ps. 119:33), establish your coming and going (Deut. 28:6), supply your needs (Philip. 4:19) and heal your broken heart (Ps. 147:3). Be determined to live a life that will fall back on the Father's Word. Regain your strength, get back up, and spring forward.



Church Musician: You're Leading Worship, Too! By Worship Cohort

There are few things more confusing to me than watching a worship team standing on the platform, and seeing the face of a worship leader who has all of his being engaged in worship of God. But then as I survey the rest of the team, I see a bass player with a too-cool-for-school scowl on his face or a guitar player with a sheepishly bewildered or bored look on his face. Or a keys player whose face

They are all worshiping the same God, right?

is completely expressionless, glued to a

sheet of music.

As believers, we are all leaders of worship. Whether standing on the platform or in the congregation, we are all collectively encouraging one another to enter into the kind of full heart, mind, soul and strength demonstration of adoration that our God desires.

This is magnified from the platform. As the privilege of influence increases, so does the responsibility of leadership. That is not confined to vocalists.

The "worship leader" is not the only one leading worship. Bass players... Keys Guitarists... players... Drummers... You're leading worship too.

Because of the various religious and cultural backgrounds the people in our churches are coming from, the need for unapologetic demonstration of "all-in" worship from the platform becomes increasingly important. Many people are longing to express this type of worship, but are simply looking for permission. Others have been burned by disorderly displays of emotional hype and need to see this done in a genuine, authentic and helpful way. Still others have never had a point of reference for this and need to see it for themselves and be coached

No matter where our people are on the spectrum, it is imperative that everyone on the platform is putting forth every effort to serve and lead them. Here are three simple ways to do this more effec-

SING LOUDLY. No believer with a voice




is exempt from the scriptural call to sing the praises of God loudly. So even if you're playing bass or keys or any other instrument—sing along! Not only will this enhance your own experience of worshiping God as you meditate on the truth of the lyrics you are singing, but you will also visibly demonstrate to the congregation the value of singing out loud the praises of God. You don't have to have mic or even a good voice, but as you play your instrument, belt it out with all you've got!


 $\textbf{SMILE BIG.} \ \ \text{Your countenance says a}$ ton about how you feel about God. For example, if you look bored, you are communicating that God is boring. It makes no sense to sing about how great and awesome God is with a smoldering scowl on your face. On the other hand, if you


are delighting in God, people will see it in your countenance and know that God is

SHOW ADORATION. True adoration is not limited to our songs and our faces. The idea of loving God with all your strength is using your entire body to express adoration to God. So while you are likely to have your hands occupied for the majority of the songs, try to find moments to raise your hands and worship in other full-body-type ways. You are an example for the church in what is appropriate expression of praise, adoration and thanksgiving to God. So don't just stand there petrified like a statue—move around.

Musicians, we are on the platform to worship and lead worship, not just to play music. So let's do everything we can to



Homeowner Assistance Fund Program

The Texas Homeowner Assistance Fund Program provides assistance to eligible homeowners in the form of Reinstatement of delinquent payments, inclusive of Property Charges such as Taxes and Homeowner's Association (HOA) fees.

The program's goal is to aid homeowners in avoiding foreclosure, on their primary residence, by providing mortgage assistance. Your lender's agreement to participate may be required, since mortgage assistance is provided directly to lenders on the homeowner's behalf

The program is administered by the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs. Funds for the Program come from the U.S. Department of Treasury, established under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021.




