
Jesus said, in John 8:32, "You will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." So, here's goes.

Long before we were bum-rushed by the SARS-CoV-2 virus, it was already a chore to get those people who'd walked up the aisle and declared that they were on the Lord's side to attend church worship services. Sports, weekends away, the seeming inability of the Church to stave off the influence of an increasingly Darwinian culture and a growing apathy and increased mobility meant that for most churches, attendance was flat or declining, and even for growing churches, growing attendance was hard work.

Now, in whatever this space we're currently in, because it's certainly isn't post-Covid, as churches around the country reopen, it's now apparent that church attendance has taken a nosedive. In fact, a recent Lifeway Research study, which analyzed church data from 34 Protestant denominations and groups, estimated that in the decade ending in 2020, 3,850 to 7,700 houses of worship closed per year in the United States, or 75 to 150 congregations per week. Pastor of Connexus Church Carey Nieuwhof comments that "the average church has seen their re-opened attendance come in around 36% of previous levels." Nieuwhof continues, "Almost no leader I've interviewed expects church attendance to jump back to pre-COVID levels for a while." In the words of the late R&B crooner Marvin Gaye, "What's going on?"

A clinician will tell you that a diagnostic error may result in the patient being denied timely, effective therapy or being administered potentially toxic, incorrect medications. Where a prompt treatment could have returned a patient to full health, the consequences of a wrong diagnosis can be devastating. Getting the right diagnosis is key for the patient.

The first step in effectively addressing the attendance crisis you're experiencing is to diagnose it accurately. The current church attendance crisis isn't medical, it's cultural. If we blame the decline in church attendance only on the he-



gemony of the SARS-CoV-2 virus, we fail to consider the cultural context that was already in place before the pandemic. Prior to the lockdowns, mask mandates and shelterin-place edicts, church attendance was already seen as something optional, something good if it helps you along in your personal spiritual life, but not something essential to your faith. Plus, today, if at all, parents don't spend a significant amount of time talking to their children about the importance of being a member of a faith community. Consequently, according to Gallup, Currently, 31% of millennials have no religious affiliation, which is up from 22% a decade ago. Similarly, 33% of the portion of Generation Z that has reached adulthood have no religious preference.

So, the church as we knew it before the pandemic will not likely reappear. The SARS-CoV-2 virus only accelerated the church's free fall. No, we don't know where the church will land. But, one thing we know for sure is that it will be different. It needs to be different. In fact, if we are to be the church to reach new people, we must show up in different and new ways. We must shed the methods that no longer serve the church and be open to being the church in new and fresh Christ-honoring ways. Rest assured that the path to the good news is blazed by leaders who keep moving through all the bad news.

"An Odd Life"

"But ye are a ... peculiar people." (1 Peter 2:9)

Have you ever questioned yourself or even the Father about being odd? Your heart has always been to love and serve God but every now and then you just want to hang out, relax and have some fun. But somehow the invitation to the evening dinner, that rocking birthday party, or weekend pool party seemed to never have made it to your inbox. You begin to wonder, "Is there something wrong me with?" "Am I off putting?" "Is everything about me so spiritual that no one wants to hang with me?'

I submit to you that you are exactly who you are supposed to beodd! The word, "odd," means unusual, strange, detached from a pair, or set; a person or thing differing in some way from the other members of a group or set. When Adam sinned, the nature of man was changed from righteous to unrighteous. Everything about mankind became detached. Mankind was supposed to reflect the Father in innocence, holiness, and righteousness but the enemy came in and separated him from the Father and expanded sin in all the earth. Jesus Christ took on the form of man, walked the earth, and became odd in the eyes of those who were blind. Yet, He reflected the Father and did nothing outside of the Father's Will. He is seated right next to the Father as the Advocate and Mediator of those who would accept Him and be willing to become odd, strange, detached from the

world, and reattached to the Father.

Every time you confess with your mouth the Almighty Father, you reflect something strange in the eyes of the angels who question why He is so mindful of you. (Ps. 8:5) Every time you surrender to the Father's Will, you detach yourself from the enemy's grips over your life. Psalm 139:14 says, "I will praise thee; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made: Marvellous are thy works, And that my soul knoweth right well." This Scripture is an affirmation of confidence of being odd. In the womb unbeknownst to my mother the enemy tried to kill and disfigure me but the Father had the final say so when he fearfully (in honor) and wonderfully (set apart) made me. You may feel "odd" because you are "odd" by the Blood of the Lamb. Never be ashamed to be the one that is distinguished from the crowd, the co-workers, the family, amongst friends, and yes even in the Church



for not all who say, "Lord, Lord," are His. Each member of the Body of Christ has a function, some are seen, and some are not seen, some work a little harder, and some do not, but together we make up one incredible representation of the Father. (1 Cor. 12)

Be not ashamed to be odd because you are surrendering to what the Father defined you to be. Everything about you is odd with a purpose. You were created from the dust of the earth - that's odd. You were redeemed by the Sacrificial Lamb of Christ - that's odd. You are the salt of the earth and the light of the world - that's odd. Every time you choose to die daily to the flesh and walk in the spirit that's odd. Thru tears and pain, you choose to trust the Father and yet praise – that's odd. You love a God whom you have not seen but by faith believe - that's odd. The world calls you odd and that's just the way it is supposed to be. So dear hearts, be determined to live an odd life on purpose.

Cowan Place-Stop Six starts new neighborhood construction

Stop Six residents, Fort Worth city leaders, developers and supporters celebrated the start of construction Thursday of Cowan Place Senior Living, a 174-unit, mixed-income community that launches six phases of new residential housing planned as part of the Stop Six Choice Neighborhood Initiative.

The groundbreaking event signals the beginning of a comprehensive transformation of one of the city's treasured, African-American communities. Cowan Place is named for Alonzo and Sarah Cowan, two of the first land owners in the southeast Fort Worth community and for whom the neighborhood was once

The multi-year Choice Neighborhood effort is seeded by a \$35 million U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development grant and includes 1,042 new residential units, neighborhood improvements and a multipurpose community hub with aquatics center that voters will consider as part of the 2022 municipal bond program.

Fort Worth Mayor Mattie Parker said the Cowan Place development is evidence of the city's commitment to strengthening its neighborhoods and ensuring that all resi-

by low-income housing tax credits that guarantee affordable rents for at least 30 years.

Cowan Place will feature one- and two-bedroom apartments designed with residents 62 and older in mind. The four-story development south of East Rosedale Street and facing Stalcup Road will feature stucco. brick and metal facades in a contemporary design notable for its lighted "lantern" that signals a bright, modern future for one of Fort Worth's historic communities.

Apartment residences will wrap around a central courtvard terraced to fit the site's natural terrain. Ground-level community spaces will include rooms for a library and theater, fitness studio, salon, billiards, crafts and space for private meetings with healthcare professionals.
