



"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

What is an appropriate strategy for leaders in the 21st century Church? Should our focus be on **solving problems** or should we primarily extend our energy trying to **develop our strengths**? Both strategies have been subscribed to in the past with varying degrees of success.

Some leaders focus on **the problems that have to be solved**. They focus on what is wrong. They ask questions like:

- Are we not reaching people?
- Is our giving below budget?
- Are we not reaching youth and children?
- Do we not have a game plan to disciple young adults?

Then, after determining what's wrong, the key questions becomes: **How can we fix the problem?**

Other leaders focus on the strengths that have been achieved. They focus on **what's right**. They ask questions like:

- Do we have an exemplary senior adult ministry?
- Is our worship service dynamic?
- Do we have an effective ministry to men?
- Are we a friendly Church?

Then, after determining what's right, the primary concern becomes: **How can we improve what we're already doing well?**

Which is the right approach? There's a growing consensus that the second approach, developing strengths, is more suitable for today's context.

Around the late 1990's, Roger Dow and Susan Cook wrote a book titled *Turned On*. *Turned On* was referred to as the definitive book on leading ordinary companies to extraordinary customer satisfaction and profits. In *Turned On*, Dow and Cook described the positive approach of Miller SQA, a subsidiary of Herman Miller. Formerly, they asked customers the usual questions: What did we do poorly? What can we improve? The response to those questions was neither passionate or practical.



All of that changed when they began to ask, "What was your most wonderful experience with Miller SQA?" Or, to put it another way, "How did we dazzle you?" They discovered that **measuring enthusiasm created enthusiasm**.

Instead of trying to adjudge what they were doing poorly, they focused instead on what they were doing right. In the words of one of their leaders, "We stalk, fan and amplify the elements of excellence."

Some years earlier, Kennon L. Callahan, in his popular book *Twelve Keys to an Effective Church*, said many pastors spent all of their time trying to discover the sources of dissatisfaction in a congregation so they can be excised. Such pastors, Callahan concluded, operate on the basis of a knee-jerk reaction to problems.

He [Callahan] suggested instead that we discover **the sources of satisfaction** so they can be developed. His strategy was to:

- Claim your strengths.
- Expand your strengths.
- Add new strengths.

While there is merit in recognizing the need at times to solve problems before progress can be made, the consensus is that the best strategy for the 21st to focus on our strengths and to build on them.

We'll talk again next month.



A Life of Rejection

"He is despised and rejected of men; A man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief." (Isaiah 53:3)

Rejection is a painful experience no matter what the cause. Everyone experiences it and affected by it to some degree. Rejection means to refuse to grant a person recognition or acceptance and to discard as worthless. The effects can destroy your self-esteem and attack your identity. It is a parasite that seeks to eat up all the nutrients that makeup who you are. It starves you of the love and acceptance that you were designed to receive.

Rejection will calibrate defects in your character, making you feel worthless, insecure and hopeless. It is rooted in abandonment and can lead to out of ordinary behavior including depression and rebellion. To compensate for the lack of feeling unloved, unapproved or unaccepted, a person operating in rejection will turn to an alternative for validation including unhealthy relationships (even abusive), fornication, pornography, drugs, alcohol, social media, or anything that will suppress the emotional damage of rejection.

Rejection craves the very opposite of what it has not received--acceptance and attachment. You will find this in the life of Laban's oldest daughter, Leah, who defined her value through the birthing of her first three sons. After the fourth son, she took her focus off the ones who rejected her, focused on God, and chose to birth praise instead of pain.

Jesus endured an undeserved rejection that many of us may never know. He was rejected by his peers, half-brothers, a nation, the Gentiles, the world He created, and the friends he loved. He experienced rejection on the cross when He cried, "Father why have you forsaken me!" Nevertheless, He conquered rejection that we might look to Him for love, validation, acceptance, approval, and healing.

God did not call His children to live a life of rejection. To shift the focus of rejection, I encourage you to do the following: 1) Recognize that Jesus knows how rejection makes you feel; 2) Decide to acknowledge rejection and all its counterparts. Denounce its strongholds; 3) Turn to God for forgiveness; 4) Let go of the expectation and approval of others—that place belongs to God; 5) Receive God's grace, compassion, and forgiveness; 6) Walk in



freedom of being liberated, and; 7) Turn that rejection into a testimony.

When you walk in rejection you do not glorify God in your body. Rather you tell Him His grace and power is insufficient. Bring your relationship with the Father in proper perspective by making Him the center of your life and source of love and approval. See yourself for who you are in God through our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Jesus endured and bore rejection and made provisions for our acceptance. So dear hearts, while we must endure rejection, we do not have to hold on to it. Rather, exchange it for acceptance in Christ, be healed, and walk in freedom.

It's an unwise person who would endanger himself and the world around him creating a fire hazard by hiding his light under a bushel! Don't hide your light once you discover it...LET IT SHINE!

What to Bring:

- Proof of ALL income for the past 30 days.



This article is created as a result of a recent 'grand' attitude I witnessed from an up and coming gospel music artist and a comment I overheard made by another recording artist. With no disrespect, I will refer to them both as "B" artists because of the level of their accomplishments in sales, record label status, audience draw and radio airplay. Hey, it is what it is and not a put down. But, in the music, film and entertainment industries, performers are measured by that criteria and even more that is not necessary to mention here. As we would imagine and understand, the more popular, in demand and financial worth a performer gains, their life styles, accessibility and demeanor even may change. They may have experienced unexpected and uncontrollable reactions from an adoring fan base that may have caused them concern for their safety. So we begin to understand the presence of security staff, back door arrivals and departures and camouflaged looks. I'm always impressed though when I hear or read about super successful entertainers who do random acts of kindness or engage with the public in regular, everyday manners. I didn't expect them to abandon their celebrity grandeur and be normal.

As they grew and exhorted the Word of God, I believed that somewhere they ministered John 12:32 about Jesus being lifted up. I believe that they have called His name and studied that His name is holy, strong, powerful, righteous, faithful, and sovereign. I can't help but to think that they've proclaimed Proverbs 18:16: "that our gifts will make room for us and set us up in high places before great people." I believe that to mean that God gave us our gifts to bring Him glory.



Responding to Midnight

Acts 16:18-30

INTRODUCTION:

With the passage of "the right to carry laws," we are caught between a rock and hard place. There is a sense of uneasiness in our society with the right to carry firearms. Today, our churches face the issues of security because there are some deranged people of society that have the audacity to kill innocent people in church. On July 26, 2019, fifty-nine people were shot in Chicago which included seven fatalities. The nation has also experienced the tragic shooting rampage in El Paso, Texas. It is believed that the majority of these crimes are motivated by hate. It is midnight when gun violence is the reason for several deaths in 2019. We must carefully seek to upgrade the gun laws in this country. We must seek the Lord in all that we begin to say and do. When men and women walk away from the Lord, then there is chaos. We must enact laws that will protect the liberties of our people.

In 2 Kings 6:17-20, there is a passage of Scripture that deals with how God can give deliverance to His children without them doing physical harm to the enemy. This is the non-violent approach that Dr. King had in mind. It was the king of Syria that contrived a plan to destroy Elisha. God allowed Elisha's servant to see the Syrian armed forces. The young servant of Elisha saw the threat of the enemy and he was filled with fear. The bible tells us that Elisha prayed for his young servant that his eyes might be opened to see that God's army of angels was much greater than the Syrian army. Satan is no match for our God. Once the young servant's eyes were opened, his fear was replaced with faith. Do you pray for the peace of the land? Since Elisha overcame his enemy's threats, we too can overcome the threats of the enemy. We can live in peace with each other if we pray and pray right. We must seek God's face.

Please note that I am not advocating that God does not want us to participate in our deliverance. Sometimes, the Lord will tell us to stand still and see the salvation of the Lord. However, on other times He will direct us to go in and possess the land. As bible scholars, we remember that Joshua and David had to fight for their destiny. Our God has many ways to bring about a change in society but we must see our deliverance through the eyes of faith and not fear. We must respond how God wants us to respond to the challenges of this life.

As we approach this month's thematic text, we will see that praying to God will bring about our deliverance. We must pray for direction in the midnight hour and let God work it out.

THE PREACHER'S TROUBLE, Acts 16:18-23

Isn't it ironic how when one decides to make up in their mind to do the right thing, evil is always present? Paul and Silas were on their way to the place of prayer but they met a young damsel that had a spirit of divination. After the apostle Paul saw the troubled damsel, he spoke to the evil spirit and commanded



that the devil come out of her. The bible clearly tells us that it was done at that very hour. Now, I need to tell you that when the Word is spoken, things happen. Paul spoke the Word to the trouble in the young damsel's life and she was delivered. How many times have we heard that no good deed goes unpunished? The business owners got upset because the woman quit the fortune telling business. I am sure that the gun owners in our land want to sell more guns but we must seek legislation that delivers us from gun violence in America. Road rage is also a major problem in America. The devil's mission statement is to steal, kill, and destroy.

The preachers got in trouble for preaching the gospel and this landed them in a dark, dingy, dungeon. Paul and Silas were falsely accused by a system that should have protected them. They were accused of sowing discord and disturbing the public peace. Isn't it funny how Paul and Silas were in the path of duty but met with trouble? It is our duty to pray for each other. The magistrates of Paul's time should have commended him for delivering the young damsel but instead Paul and Silas were beaten with many stripes and dumped into a jail cell. How many times have innocent men and women lost their freedom and lives to a corrupt system of injustice? Does justice only go to the privileged in our land? We live in a troubled society yet God is able to deliver us from the hand of the enemy. When innocent people are killed or imprisoned, I suggest to you that we are at midnight.

THE PREACHER'S PRAYER MEETING, Acts 16:25-26

The bible tells us that Paul prayed and Silas sang. We too must have a prayer on our lips and a melody in our hearts when times get tough. We cannot afford to lose our faith in God. When we look at the Scripture, we find that God sees every situation that we are confronted with and He can deliver. It has always been the wisdom of God's people to seek the Lord at all times. We must not forget the struggles of our forefathers and we must seek to honor Dr. King's dream by living our dream. But, we have to pray that our dream is within the will of God. According to v. 25-26, the bible tells us that an earthquake shook the cell where the Paul and Silas were kept. When God gets ready, He can shake up an unjust situation and cause our circumstances to change. The bible tells us that the chains fell off. Do you hear the chains falling off? Someone is in chains in their mind because they feel that there is no way out. We must continue to teach our people to educate themselves so that they are not victims of a selfish society. We

must continue to encourage our children in the field of medicine, engineering, computer science, law, law enforcement, social work, architecture, and etc. We must walk in the light of God's love. Love is the only thing that can overcome hate. Love can bring down a corrupt system of injustices. Paul and Silas were engaged in a prayer meeting that was so powerful, the ground got happy and released the prisoners. Psalms 46:1 tells us that "God is our refuge and a very present help in the time of trouble." He will deliver you from all of your suffering. Do you believe that God is able to deliver in the midnight hour?

THE PEOPLE'S POSSIBILITIES, Acts 16:27-30

In these verses, we see that the jailor became frightened when he saw the release of Paul and Silas from jail. We know that what the devil has meant for evil, God can turn it around. The bible tells us that the jailor called for lights and brought Paul and Silas out. The praise in this passage is that the jailor had a question. He asked, "What must I do to be saved?" When we are in the path of duty, God will work it out for us. When people come to accept Jesus as their personal Savior, there are great possibilities.

In closing, what has the devil done in your life to keep you on lockdown? If you can look unto Jesus, he can make everything alright. It was Paul and Silas that received their walking papers from a Philippian jail cell because God had their back. Remember, what the Lord has done for others, he can do for you. Jesus is the same yesterday, today, and forever more. The Lord can free you from a spirit of depression. The Lord can release you from drug addiction. What is it that is keeping you from walking out of your prison? Today, you can be free if you allow the Spirit of God to lead and guide you. Paul and Silas got delivered because they had faith in the Lord. Let's respond to the trouble in our land through the eyes of faith. You have to see yourself graduating from the university. You have to see yourself in that new home. You have to see yourself with that new job. You have to see yourself in a healthy relationship. However, one cannot expect to receive something different by doing the same old things. As a people, we have to prepare ourselves so that when life presents an opportunity, we can be ready for success in life. Although we are confronted with struggles in life, we are more than a conqueror. We can enact legislation to lift the burden of "the right to carry laws." If we approach our midnight the right way, we can be delivered. Elisha, Paul and Silas sought God for direction and they were delivered. Our God has many ways to bring about a change. We must acknowledge God in all that we begin to say and do. Do you have the right response to midnight?
