“The LEADER’S EDGE” by drmichaelbell

As the pandemic recedes in the United States and in-person services resume, it’s becoming increasingly apparent that some houses of worship won’t make it. Prior to Covid, church attendance in many communities was flat or declining. And, now that in-person worship has resumed at least on some level, pastors and church leaders are finding that like Little Bo Peep of Mother Goose nursery rhyme fame, some sheep are missing.



Just to remind you, when the novel coronavirus pandemic first hit this country supermarkets, hardware stores, gas stations, pet stores, laundromats, liquor stores, marijuana dispensaries and golf courses were considered “essential.” Gyms, movie theaters, casinos, retail stores, sports stadiums, concert venues and churches were considered “nonessential.” Historically, our faith gatherings have played a tremendous role in seeing us through difficult and distressing times. But, the shelter-in-place and lockdown orders communicated a message that the Church is nice to have, but in no way necessary. In-person worship was prohibited and many Churches shifted to virtual services over the past year, and now that some restrictions have been lifted many churches started welcoming back in-person worshippers a few months ago but the regular worship crowd still hasn’t shown up.

What has happened? Frankly, it’s complicated. One answer is that the low church attendance most churches are experiencing isn’t pandemic-related, it’s cultural. Going on two years into the pandemic, people have developed some new habits: participating from home, or, sometimes, not participating at all in church. A recent study revealed that, in some cases, about one-third of practicing Christians say that they haven’t logged in to any worship service since the pandemic began.

The decline of in-person attendance means a new strategy is called for, at least if you want to reach people. As hard it may be for many pastors

and church leaders to embrace the digital church as the new default, it’s the new reality. No, in-person gatherings aren’t going away, but the bottom line is online connections will help you reach more people than ever.

So, get ready for some meaningful leadership strategy sessions. A third of our regular crowd might not ever come back, now what? Let us take it a step farther and confess that among that might-not-ever-come-back crowd are some pre-Covid ministry leaders, deacons, trustees and even preachers. I and many of my pastor colleagues have been caught off-guard by the unaccounted for used-to-be church leaders and the church leaders who are, in some cases, literally hanging on by a thread. Both create a whole new set of issues. But, right now that’s not on the front burner. Then, you might ask, where should my church leadership focus our attention?

A simple place to start is to retool your church leadership. You’ll find some people are more wired toward technology and others more toward relationship. As much as we might want everything to go back to normal, you can’t go back to normal when normal no longer exists. Don’t wait for the world to throw your church another curveball. You can be more prepared for what’s next if you continually seek creative ways to reach people no matter the landscape.

“A Shifted Life”

“And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven: And he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why persecutest thou me?” (Acts. 9:3-4)

Apostle Paul is no stranger to the Christian faith. The writer of one third of the New Testament, his initial outlook on the Church was hostile and he was zealous to wreak havoc upon her. Having possessed such an impressive background (Philip. 3:5-6), he appeared to be the right candidate for the job. However, the Father in His mercy chose to shift Paul’s occupation and use him for His glory. Paul’s intention was to enter Damascus to persecute but the Father shifted that thing and he came out preaching.

The word shift means a change in direction or position. The Bible lets us know that unto each of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. (Eph 4:7) Since the Father is the Giver, He has a right to determine how He wants to use His investment for the greater purpose of the Kingdom. He will shift your plans to line them up with His plans. (Prov. 19:21)

I developed a love for music and singing at an early age and entered into the music ministry serving as Minister of Music for many years. I was deeply passionate about praise and worship because that was my safe

place which I could do in my sleep. However, the Father shifted that thing when Holy Spirit told me to come from behind the mic, “the place of comfort,” and called me to be an evangelist, “the place of challenge.” It takes much effort, fasting, praying, studying, a bunch of mistakes, trials, tests, etc., when you are called into ministry. Singing was so much easier, but I had to yield to the shift because God willed it to be so.

One of the greatest shifts for my family was being called from California to Texas. We sold our home, possessions, said goodbye to family, our California Church of 22 years, and shifted our way to a place we knew nothing about, but we had a Word and faith to build the ministry. I want to encourage you not to resist God’s shifting in your life and to embrace some wisdom steps.

Step One: Do not rush God’s shift. Paul was rendered blind and postured himself to a place of fasting and praying before God sent his healing, deliverance, and further direction. It took us a year to transition from California to Texas. When God shifts you, if you try to rush into what He has revealed to you, it will cause more harm than good.

Step Two: Take the time to redevelop yourself in the shifted assignment. Paul took about three years to redevelop himself to be prepared for the “great sufferings” he would endure for the gospel. (Gal. 1:17-18). He was an expert in the law yet had to take time to reflect, ponder and meditate on his conversion. We too, found ourselves having to take



time to learn the Texas culture.

Step Three: Be open to Barnabas. God sent Barnabas in Paul’s life to help pave the way for a great gospel platform amongst those who were skeptical. A visit from our Superintendent afforded us to be introduced to Johnny & Bobbie Castleberry who became our spiritual parents paving the way for many platforms for us to grow and share the ministry.

Step Four: Do not get stuck in the shift. I owned a car that was a stick shift and could not get that thing out of second gear because it got stuck and had to call upon the mechanic to get it unstuck. Paul’s heart’s desire was towards the Jews, but God shifted that thing to the Gentiles. Remember, the Father has a right to shift you anytime and anyplace as He chooses.

So dear hearts, the Father who has endowed you with your own unique grace gifts, has a right to shift you anywhere and anytime He chooses. You are His investment, and He has a Kingdom purpose for you. Be determined to go with the shift.

Victory in the Valley

Exodus 17:8-16

1. Introduction

Most of us are familiar with the ups and downs of life. Storms are ever-present in our lives. There are times when the sun is shining in the morning, but later in the evening a storm can arise. There is nothing that you can do about storm clouds gathering. Hurricane IDA has hit the gulf coast and caused lots of damage, but God is still able. God can rescue and restore. Are there any storms in your life? Do you have any rivers to cross? Is there anything too hard for God? Jesus encouraged us in John 16:33, "In this world, you will have tribulation but be of good cheer." "I have overcome the world."

In Exodus 17:1-7, there is a great prelude to the text. In v.1, a storm cloud arose due to the want of water in the camp. Here, we ascertain the classic case of spiritual amnesia. The Lord God had already brought the Israelites out of Egyptian bondage and he made a highway for them through the Red Sea. The Lord God had given them manna when they were hungry. Nevertheless, a complaint arose in the camp against God's servant Moses. The Israelites complained so much that Moses was almost stoned by the people. This behavior is typical of those that forget God's goodness to them. They are quick to focus on people rather than on God. Our God has never lost a battle and He is ready and willing to help us in the time of our storms. If the Israelites could have remembered what God had already done for them, they would have been encouraged. God is the same yesterday, today, and forever more! If God did it then, He can do it again!

Although the some of the Israelites wanted to stone Moses, I like the fact that Moses did not focus on his accusers. Moses turned his attention to God and he prayed. When we pray, God already knows all about it but we need to talk to the Lord. Moses prayed and God answered his prayers. The Lord God answered Moses's prayer by instructing him to strike the rock. When Moses obeyed God and struck the rock, water came out and quenched the thirsty of the Israelites. It is important to note that some of our problems is because of what we have done. The Israelites got in trouble with God when they quarreled with Moses. The Lord God allowed their enemy to attack them. It's dangerous when we fail to recognize God as the source of our solutions. Are there any doubters of the Lord God? Do you trust Him to put food on your table and give you water when you are thirsty?

2. Position of the Leaders, v.8-10

It is in these verses that we see that after the Israelites had a mountain-top experience, they experienced some trouble. When one experiences a blessing in your life, one should watch out for the devil. The Lord God had blessed the Israelites with the miracle of water coming from a rock. However, in verse 8, we ascertain the trouble in their life. The bible says that Amalek attacked Israel from the back. When you have been blessed with good health, money in the bank, good family, and good friends, this is a time when one should be most careful. The devil's mission statement is to



steal, kill, and destroy. When we look at the life of Job, we find that Job was doing well in chapter 1. However, in the same chapter, Job's character and family was attacked.

Please allow me to give proper perspective regarding Amalek. Amalek was a descendant of Esau. We know that Esau hated Jacob because of the birthright situation. Amalek was the grandson of Esau. Although Esau had a problem with Jacob, this should not have caused Amalek to have the same problem. There are some people in this world that will hate you because of your association with a certain family member or friend. Some people may dislike you because of something that they heard about you. Have you ever had someone to dislike you because of your father or mother?

The Lord God became angry with Amalek because of the way they attacked the Israelites. It was a cowardly act to attack someone from the back. It was a cowardly act to kill those (13) service men in Afghanistan. It is a cowardly act to mistreat the people in your country. There are times in our lives when God may say, "stand still and see the salvation of the Lord." However, there are times in our lives when the Lord may want us to participate in our own deliverance. Here is a case when the Lord God wanted Moses to participate in the battle. As we travel in the text, we see that Moses nominated Joshua as the commander-in-chief of the Israelites. It was Joshua's responsibility to select men for war. Joshua had a responsibility to fight the battle in the valley. Moses took the position of intercessor/prayer warrior for the Israelites. The Word informs us that Moses, Aaron, and Hur went to the top of the hill. Our God has different responsibilities for His people. Joshua had to fight in the valley while Moses prayed for the people at the top of the hill. It is important to note that Moses had some help from Aaron and Hur.

3. Problem of the Leaders, v. 11-13

The bibles inform us that Moses, Aaron, and Hur were at the top of the hill. However, Moses arms became weary and he needed some help. When Moses arms were lifted, the army of the

Israelites were winning the battle. But, when Moses arms drooped, the Israelites were losing the battle. Aaron and Hur helped keep Moses arms raised and this had a positive outcome on the battle. This biblical passage should teach us that we need to be careful in life who we take with us. If one takes the right people, then one can obtain the right kind of help. In verse 11, the bible tells us that Aaron and Hur took a stone to help keep Moses arms elevated. In this life, one will find that they need some divine assistance.

The God that we serve is not like Moses. He never needs to take a break. His arms do not get tired. He is our strength and refuge in the time of a storm. When one encounters the storms of life, please remember that God is able.

4. Power of God, v. 14-16

In these verses, we see a profound declaration of the Lord God. In verse 14, the Lord said to Moses, write this for a memorial in the book and recount it in the hearing of Joshua, that I will blot out the remembrance of Amalek from under the heaven. When the Lord God takes on your enemy, you can go to sleep. God instructed Moses to write the victory in the valley down in the book. This was the first battle that the Israelites fought and the Lord gave them the victory. God is always operating but are you participating? There was a national sentence that Amalek wanted to get rid of the Israelites. But God had other plans. We must be careful when we seek someone else's demise. God has a way of taking care of His children. The Lord said that He would blot out the remembrance of Amalek.

I am so glad that our God has a way of blotting out somethings. Aren't you glad that He has blotted out your transgressions? Are you glad that when the Lord God looks at the work of His Son, we are forgiven by faith in Jesus Christ? Aren't you glad that the Lord God can take care of you despite your enemies in life? We see the power of God because our God has never lost a battle. If you need healing, He can give you healing. If you need a friend, He will be your best friend. If you need to pay your bills, the Lord God is ready and willing to help you. It is my prayer that you will trust the Lord God when you don't understand what He is doing in your life. God will take care of you. He took care of the Israelites when they got in trouble and He will see you through!

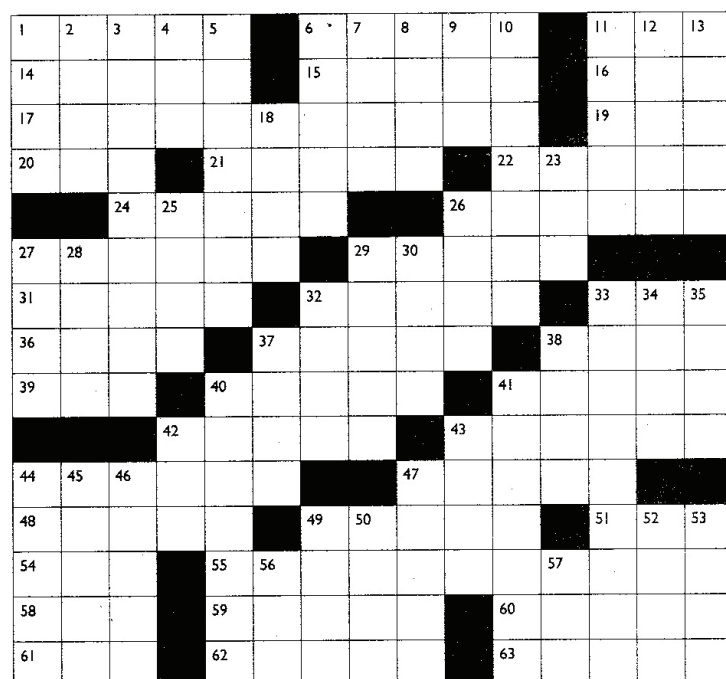
