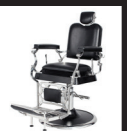

"The LEADER'S EDGE" by drmichaelbell

Our God is a creative God. In fact, creativity was God's idea. Creativity is part of the very nature and character of God. The fifth word in the Bible is created—"In the beginning God created ..." (*Genesis 1:1*). God kicked off the creative process and it's been moving forward ever since.



We, you and I, are to be imitators of God. We are created in God's image and after God's likeness (*Genesis 1:27*)! This means we are designed to be creative too! You have a unique contribution to make. Effective Church leaders tap into creativity every day to solve problems, think in new ways, develop people and innovate toward a better future.

This is the 21st Century and both pastors and lay leaders must meet the variegated challenges couching at the Church door. Why is creativity so critical, especially during this season?

Number one, **creativity enables us to apply Biblical truths** to contemporary situations. Being creative enables us to connect Biblical truth to daily life.

Number two, whether you're a Sunday School teacher (*or whatever the spiritual formation vehicle is called at the Church where you serve*) or a Preacher, **creativity enhances the preaching/teaching moment**. Creative speakers are interesting and engaging; not humdrum and mid-dling.

Number three, **creativity improves our problem-solving**. Problems require solutions, and solutions necessitate creativity. If we continue to approach our problems with antiquated attempts at solutions, we shouldn't be surprised when we flop. On the other hand, when we face our problems with the freshness of creativity, successful solutions will materialize.

Number four, **creativity augments our leadership and our ability to minister to others**. Our ability to point the way forward and to encourage people to follow is partly dependent upon

our creative ability. Motivation, insight, vision, decision-making, problem-solving are improved by creativity.

I hear you asking, "How do I become creative?" Here are two or three tips to start you up the path to creativity.

First, make time for thinking creatively. Set aside regular time for brainstorming by yourself and, better still, with other people - especially with any teams that you are a part of. Think creatively.

Second, ask good questions. Good questions help us gain a new perspective on our current context. Regularly ask yourself, "What's working well and why?" and "What's not working and why?"

Third, be a strategic listener. Expose yourself to different viewpoints. Study people's needs and ideas, then look for future trends. We can learn something from everyone, if we will just listen attentively.

Fourth, think outside the box. Create an atmosphere within your team that says, "Let's find a better way." Always be looking for a new idea that will improve or expand your ministry.

Five, be willing to take a risk. Don't be afraid of failure. Conduct an experiment. Just try something new and different. Learn to fail forward.

"Speak Life Thought"

"A Life Possessed with A Purpose"

"All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals and to prayer...all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved." (Acts 2:42, 47 NLT)

After Pentecost the early church became possessed with a purpose to spread the Gospel message. Of importance was building a community amongst themselves so that purpose could continue to be fulfilled. Possess means to have an ability, quality or characteristic; it also means to dominate the mind such as an emotion, idea, etc. Purpose means the reason for which something is done. We learn from the early church that to be possessed with purpose is to have an unwavering determination to achieve a goal.

The early church believers had such a love and passion for community fellowship they were willing to volunteer their time and dedicate resources to benefit the beauty of the Gospel. It was a good system not void of problems: untruthfulness in giving (Acts 5:1), improper distribution to widows (6:1), and laziness (2 Thess

3:7-10), to name a few, which prompted Paul to occasionally demonstrate bi-vocational living. Yet, despite the existence of these problems, they did not negate the harmony and unity that this system produced, which was good fruit.

What would make a people want to be so possessed with such a purpose? They were taught and understood purpose. There are three components of purpose:

1) **Kingdom Purpose:** Every believer is afforded the opportunity to be endowed with the Holy Ghost to build community. We as a body of believers are given something to do motivated by sharing the love of Jesus. That is Kingdom Purpose.

2) **Family Purpose:** We are given the responsibility to create a healthy environment for family to learn and grow in spiritual and moral principles and values. (See Eph. 6:1-4)

3) **Individual Purpose:** Every believer receives not just natural endowments but graces and capacities for service. No one is ever meant to be idle and each one has a place to fill. Envy has no place amongst brothers and sisters for each of us have been fully loaded. (Eph 4:7)

The result of purpose can be found in verse 47, "The Lord added daily those who would be saved." There is such great power and value in the Gospel message and the enemy is doing all



he can to shut up your testimony. The Father has considered you worthy to live and not die. You are a story worth sharing and telling others about through the saving grace of Jesus Christ.

The Church enjoyed great peace and experienced tremendous growth but not without a price of persecution and opposition. The Church today is experiencing opposition in what we can and cannot say, the Family is under attack with being redefined, and we are under daily attack from the enemy to take possessions of our souls. But there is a Greater Power that is available to endow you to become Possessed with Purpose to see great results for the Kingdom, your Family, and for you. So dear hearts, be determined to receive, walk, live, fulfill and be POSSESSED WITH PURPOSE.

Excerpts from Napoleon Hill's "Outwitting the Devil"

"Recognize that life is a cruel taskmaster and that either you master it or it masters you. There is no half-way or compromising point. Never accept in life anything you do not want. If that which you do not want is temporarily forced, you can refuse, in your own mind to accept it, and it will make way for the thing you do want"

Here are the takeaways from the book Outwitting The Devil:

Every self mastery starts at some point. It can happen either after a tragic event or in a much easier way — such as intentional self contemplation.

Every person should not be LAZY to think, and to evaluate what are the causes that leads him to the life he is currently experiencing.

That on discovering this cause and effect a person must not allow himself to FEAR what the life will expose. Instead, he should use this as opportunity to learn and evaluate his course.

There are people who are known to be DRIFTERS — the drifters are those who allow to sleepwalk their life.

Life is not like driving a car where a person only operates everything subconsciously. Life is like a painting, you brew your idea every night, you plan which color to compliment, and on that very day when you start your painting you are mindful on every stroke.

"People who think accurately do not drift on any subject. They recognize the power of their own mind. Moreover, they take over that power and yield it to no person of influence"

Believe that you are 100% capable to improve, yourself cannot maximise that potential unless you believe it to be true.

Don't leave unfinished thoughts hanging. Don't quit when you are entering a thought that requires a mental effort. Never fear the unknown. Reach the definite decision.

All solutions require thoughtful effort, not with shallowness, great solutions rarely found on the surface.

If you will not deliberately fill up the majority of your thinking with positivity, the opposite will fill it in.

Solitude is far more better than meaningless entertainment. Distractions will never be extinct.

Strength cannot be tested on comfort zone or in a convenient route. Mental toughness should not be reserved for repairing troubles, it's a resource that is always available for creating something meaningful.

"Mind not only forms our inner landscape; it creates our circumstances."

Being invincible from the Devil is guarding yourself from its influences. Defining a purpose will never happen by chance.

Thought ability is also a resource that atrophies.

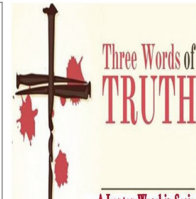

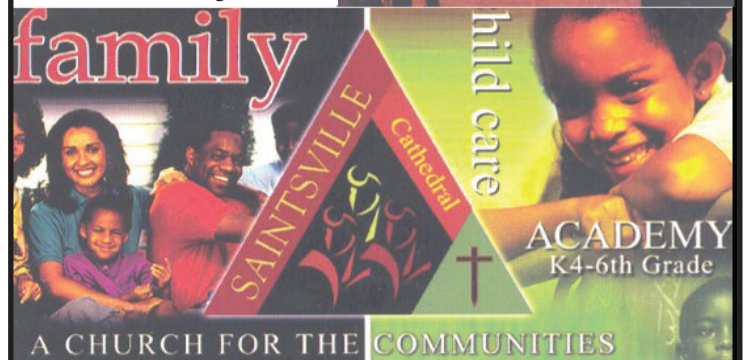

Reasons for Worship

2 Samuel 6:12-21

1. Introduction

There are times when one may not feel as if there is a need for worship because of current circumstances. When one trouble ends, there is another challenge on the horizon. Sometimes the problem may be that the people giving you the most trouble are the ones that should be celebrating with you. Some people are not able to celebrate with you because they are envious of you. There is no need for jealousy in the body of Christ. If the Lord is blessing your neighbor, it is just a matter of time before the blessing comes to your doorstep. As Christians, we should remember that if the Lord is blessing our neighbor, it simply means the Lord is in our neighborhood. We must wait until our change comes.

As we approach the text, we find that David is engaged in a worship experience. However, something goes wrong along the way. In 2 Samuel 6:7, we find that Uzzah is struck dead for his miscarriage of the ark. The bible states that the anger of the Lord was kindled against Uzzah. This costly mistake by Uzzah was tragic. In verse 8 of the text, we find that David became upset with the Lord. Have you ever been upset with God? Sometimes people blame God when they should really look to see if they are part of the problem. David should have made sure that his people were carrying the ark of the covenant per the instructions of the Lord. It was clearly stated in the Old Testament how the ark of the covenant was to be carried. The error that was made is that they carried the ark of the covenant in a cart and it should have been carried by the priests. After the death of Uzzah, David decided to carry the ark of the covenant down to Obed-Edom's house.

2. Helpful Hints, v.11-12

In verse 11-12, we find that the Lord blessed Obed-Edom's household. There was an increase for Obed-Edom because he was obedient unto the Lord. When we are obedient to the Lord, then the Lord will bless us. When we are contrary to God's commandments, the Lord's wrath may become kindled against us. If we could poll Uzzah, he would tell you that it is better to do it God's way. We find that after David received word that Obed-Edom's household was blessed because of the ark of the covenant, David decided to bring the ark back to Jerusalem. When we have God's presence with us, we are indeed a blessed people.



There are many instances in Scripture where it is stated that the Lord's presence with His people is important. When Moses crossed the Red Sea, he could not have made it without the Lord on his side. If the Lord is with us, He is more than the world against us. When Daniel was thrown into the lion's den, we find that the Lord was with Daniel in the lion's den. The Lord allowed the lions to become a soft pillow for Daniel to rest upon. When we as a people think about what the Lord has done for us, our souls should get happy. We know that the Lord has been with black Americans because we have endured a Jim Crow era. We have endured the dreadful nights of slavery and its grip on American culture. We have overcome somethings in America, but we still have some work to do.

As David began to think things over, he began to think about the goodness of the Lord to Obed-Edom. When we think soberly, we will begin to worship the Lord. David is now re-engaged in the worship experience. He exchanges his royal purple robe for a plain linen ephod. David did not want anything to get in the way of his praises unto God. Is there anything that is keeping you from praising the Lord?

3. In-House Hindrances, v. 16-20

In these verses, we find that Saul's daughter Michal caught a glimpse of the praise party through a window. The bible says that Michal saw David leaping, dancing, and praising God in the plain linen ephod. The Word tells us that she despised David for praising the Lord. We should never let anyone hinder our praise. Has anyone caused you not to give praises unto our God? Have you ever sat next to someone on the pews that dampened your spirit toward praising God?

As we read the story of David, we find that David was steadfast, unmovable, and unshakeable in the praise. David knew where his help came from. David knew that the Lord was angry with Uzzah because Uzzah did not do it God's way. However, when David saw the blessing of the Lord upon Obed-Edom, David knew that God is a God of mercy. When we think about what the Lord has done in

our lives, we should give the Lord our praises. When praises go up, blessings come down.

4. Insight of His Help, v. 20-21

In these verses, we find that David remembered where he came from. David expressed to Michal that the Lord brought him from taking care of sheep to the kingship in Israel. David said in verse 21, "It was before the Lord, which chose me before thy father, and before all of his house. David remembered that his earthly father may have overlooked him as a potential king, but the Lord God remembered David. The oil would only flow on David and it did not flow on his brothers. David's brothers may have look like a king on the outside, but God knew something about David. David remembered that God does not look at the outward appearance, but He looks at the heart. As we scan the canvas of our lives, believers should be able to look where the Lord has brought them from. The Lord has brought us from the back of the bus to owning the bus lines. The Lord has brought us from sharecroppers to farming our own land. The Lord has brought us from having very little education to teaching at the highest universities in the land. When I think about what the Lord has done for me, my soul shouts "yes to the Lord!" The Lord woke me up this morning and started me on our way. The Lord has allowed me to have good health and a sound mind. I must tell Him thank you.

As we close out this scripture, let's remember that our God deserves the highest praise because of what He has already done in our lives. Do not allow any type of hindrance to cause you to not praise the Lord. We must not allow sickness, sadness, or situations to cause us to doubt God. When we allow the Holy Spirit to lead us on this earth, we will find that a crown awaits us in glory!!!
